- 18 Japan on the staff of the Commander of Naval Forces; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Ms. Sanders returned to the Delta in 1972, where she
- 20 has remained an active member of her community for many years,
- 21 having been instrumental in the planning and building of the
- 22 Veterans Monument in Greenwood, which was dedicated in 1999; and
- WHEREAS, in addition, Ms. Sanders serves on the Foundation
- 24 Board at Delta State University, the Board of the Cottonlandia
- 25 Museum and is an active member of Sidon United Methodist Church;
