HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 49

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE INGOMAR BOYS
2 HIGH SCHOOL BASKETBALL TEAM ON THEIR OUTSTANDING 2000-2001 SEASON.

13 produced a solid third place effort in the overall state
