- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. In any civil action brought against a premises
- 6 owner by a person who alleges injury occurring on the premises of
- 7 another as a result of a criminal act of a third party, the
- 8 premises owner shall not be liable unless he actually knew the
- 9 criminal act was occurring or was about to occur and failed to
- 10 exercise reasonable care to protect the person from the criminal
- 11 act.
- For the purposes of this section, the term "premises owner"
- 13 includes, without limitation, an authorized agent or a person in
- 14 possession of real property and a person legally responsible for
- 15 the condition of real property or for the activities conducted or
- 16 circumstances existing on real property.
- 17 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 2001.
