SENATE BILL NO. 2155

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF COAHOMA
 2 COUNTY TO PURCHASE RADAR SPEED DETECTION EQUIPMENT FOR USE BY THE
 3 SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT OF THE COUNTY IN THE ENFORCEMENT OF SPEED
 4 LIMITS ON THE ROADS, STREETS AND HIGHWAYS OF THE COUNTY OUTSIDE
 5 THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF ANY INCORPORATED MUNICIPALITY; AND FOR
 6 RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors of Coahoma County may
 9 expend out of any available funds of the county, an amount that
 10 the board determines is sufficient for the purchase and use by the
 11 sheriff's department of the county of radar speed detection
 12 equipment. If the board of supervisors authorizes the expenditure
 13 of funds for this purpose, then the Sheriff of Coahoma County and
 14 any duly sworn deputy sheriff of the county may operate and use
 15 the equipment to enforce the motor vehicle speed limits on any
 16 public road, street or highway within the county outside the
 17 corporate limits of any incorporated municipality.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
 19 and after its passage.
