COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2203

AN ACT TO DEFINE THE COMPREHENSIVE COUNSELING SERVICES TO BE 1 PROVIDED BY SCHOOL GUIDANCE COUNSELORS, TO INCLUDE CRISIS 2 3 INTERVENTION AND PREVENTION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. Beginning with the 2001-2002 school year, the 5 assignment of K-12 school guidance counselors to the particular 6 schools within the district shall be at the discretion of the 7 local school board with the following restrictions: 8 (a) No individual shall be employed as a school 9 guidance counselor without appropriate training and certification 10 as determined by the State Department of Education; and 11 (b) School guidance counselors shall be professional 12 13 personnel and shall spend a majority of work time in direct counseling relationships with students. 14 School guidance counselors shall provide the following 15 (2) comprehensive counseling services: 16 Academic and personal/social counseling; 17 (a) Student assessment and assessment counseling; 18 (b) Career and educational counseling; 19 (C) 20 (d) Individual and group counseling (large/small); 21 (e) Crisis intervention and preventive counseling; 22 (f) Referrals to community agencies; Educational consultations and collaboration with 23 (g) teachers, administrators, parents and community leaders; 24 Educational and career placement services; 25 (h) 26 (i) Follow-up counseling services; and 27 (j) Conflict resolution.

31 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 32 and after July 1, 2001.
