SENATE BILL NO. 2325

1 AN ACT TO ADOPT THE MISSISSIPPI STATE FLAG; AND FOR RELATED
2 PURPOSES.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 SECTION 1. (1) The Mississippi State Flag shall have the
5 following design: with width two-thirds (2/3) of its length; with
6 a field of old glory blue; with a white circle bordered with gold
7 and centered in the middle of the field, with a diameter of
8 one-half (1/2) the width of the field; with the circle to contain
9 a seal depicting the New State Capitol and a magnolia blossom with
10 leaves over a watermark (gray) outline of the State of
11 Mississippi, with the words "THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI" on the
12 upper border of the circle and the words "THE MAGNOLIA STATE" on
13 the lower border of the circle; the staff surmounted with a
14 spearhead and a battle axe below, and the flag to be fringed with
15 gold and the staff gilded with gold.

16 (2) The Governor of the state is authorized and empowered to
17 procure a Mississippi State Flag of proper dimensions which shall
18 be preserved in the Office of the Adjutant General of the state
19 and Office of the Secretary of State.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
21 and after its passage.
