SENATE BILL NO. 2389

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-9-153, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO PROVIDE THAT AN EMPLOYEE OF ANY STATE AGENCY, DEPARTMENT, 3 BOARD, COMMISSION, INSTITUTION OR OTHER INSTRUMENTALITY OF THE 4 STATE MAY OPERATE A STATE-OWNED MOTOR VEHICLE IF THE EMPLOYEE HAS 5 A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE FROM A CONTIGUOUS STATE; AND FOR RELATED 6 PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 SECTION 1. Section 25-9-153, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 9 25-9-153. (1) An employee of any state agency, department, 10 board, commission, institution or other instrumentality of the 11 12 state may not operate a state-owned motor vehicle unless such person has a valid Mississippi driver's license or a valid 13 14 driver's license from a contiguous state.

15 (2) A violation of subsection (1) of this section16 constitutes good cause for dismissal from employment.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
