- 8 SECTION 1. Section 25-9-153, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 25-9-153. (1) An employee of any state agency, department,
- 11 board, commission, institution or other instrumentality of the
- 12 state may not operate a state-owned motor vehicle unless such
- 13 person has a valid Mississippi driver's license or a valid
- 14 driver's license from a contiguous state.
- 15 (2) A violation of subsection (1) of this section
- 16 constitutes good cause for dismissal from employment.
- 17 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after its passage.
