## SENATE BILL NO. 2406

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-55-25, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REMOVE THE PROVISION THAT PROHIBITS DUPLICATES OF LOST OR 3 DESTROYED WARRANTS FROM BEING ISSUED UNTIL AN AFFIDAVIT AND A BOND 4 ARE FILED WITH THE OFFICER ISSUING THE DUPLICATE; TO AMEND SECTION 5 25-55-27, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY THERETO; AND FOR 6 RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 25-55-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:

25-55-25. A duplicate for a lost or destroyed bond \* \* \* 10 shall not issue until there shall have been filed with the officer 11 an affidavit and a bond. The affidavit must be that of some 12 13 credible person knowing the facts, and it must set forth the ownership of such bond \* \* \*, the number of unpaid coupons, if 14 any, thereto attached, and the description thereof, embracing, if 15 can be, its number, to whom and for what issued, its date and when 16 mature. The bond must be that of a person to whom the duplicate 17 is to be issued, with at least two (2) sufficient sureties, in a 18 19 sum equal to double the amount of the lost, destroyed or stolen bond \* \* \*, payable to the state, conditioned to pay all damages 20 21 which the state, county, city, town, or levee board, as the case may be, may sustain if compelled to pay such bond or 22 coupons \* \* \*, together with all costs and expenses and lawyers' 23 24 fees, if any, incurred in enforcing the bond.

25 SECTION 2. Section 25-55-27, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 26 amended as follows:

27 25-55-27. Any officer issuing duplicates of bonds \* \* \*28 shall keep a record showing:

(a) The numbers, dates and amounts of such mutilated, 29 lost or destroyed bonds \* \* \* and of the coupons thereto attached; 30 (b) \* \* \* The date of the issuance of the 31 duplicate; \* \* \* 32 (c) The name of the person to whom the duplicate was 33 issued; and 34 35 The name of the sureties and penalty of the (d) indemnity bond, if a bond is required. 36 The officer issuing duplicates of bonds shall preserve the 37 bond and affidavit taken in each case. 38 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 39 40 and after July 1, 2001.
