| 7 | SECTION 1. Section 65-1-173, Mississippi Code of 1972, is |
| 8 | amended as follows: |
| 9 | 65-1-173. For the purpose of enforcing and investigating all |
| 10 | violations of the railroad laws, and the rules, regulations and |
| 11 | general orders of the Mississippi Transportation Commission |
| 12 | promulgated thereunder, the commission is hereby authorized to |
| 13 | employ $\underline{\text{six (6)}}$ inspectors * * *. The salaries of the |
| 14 | inspectors * * * shall be fixed by the commission, subject to the |
| 15 | state personnel system law as provided under Section 25-9-101 et |
| 16 | seq. The inspectors shall devote their full time to the |
| 17 | performance of their duties and shall take an oath faithfully to |
| 18 | perform the duties of their positions. The commission shall |
| 19 | require bonds to be carried on such employees as the commission |
| 20 | may deem necessary, the cost thereof to be paid by the commission. |
| 21 | The inspectors shall be selected after an examination, as |
| 22 | prescribed by the commission, as to physical and mental fitness, |
| 23 | knowledge of the railroad laws, the rules and regulations of the |
