COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2422

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH IN THE STATE TREASURY THE ELECTRONIC 1 2 GOVERNMENT SERVICES FUND INTO WHICH SHALL BE DEPOSITED FUNDS 3 APPROPRIATED BY THE LEGISLATURE FOR DEVELOPING AND PROVIDING 4 ELECTRONIC GOVERNMENT SERVICES WITHIN THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI; TO ESTABLISH AN ELECTRONIC GOVERNMENT SERVICES OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE TO 5 MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE EXPENDITURE OF SUCH FUNDS AND THE 6 7 DEVELOPMENT OF ELECTRONIC MEDIA GOVERNMENT SERVICES IN THE STATE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 SECTION 1. (1) There is established in the State Treasury 10 11 the "Electronic Government Services Fund," into which shall be deposited specific funds appropriated by the Legislature for 12 developing and providing electronic government services within the 13 State of Mississippi. Any funds in the Electronic Government 14 Services Fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the 15 State General Fund, but shall be available for expenditure in the 16 subsequent fiscal year. The funds in the Electronic Government 17 18 Fund shall be available for expenditure pursuant to specific appropriation by the Legislature beginning in fiscal year 2002, to 19 the Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services, and 20 shall be expended exclusively for developing and providing 21 electronic media government services within the State of 22 Mississippi. 23

There is hereby established an Electronic Government 24 (2)25 Oversight Committee to monitor and make recommendations regarding the expenditure of funds for electronic government services 26 statewide and to initiate study, planning and coordination of 27 28 electronic government services within the State of Mississippi. The Electronic Government Oversight Committee shall be authorized 29 to approve the design on any state electronic media portal or 30

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website published by any agency of state government. 31 In addition, 32 the committee shall develop and make recommendations for all expenditures from the Electronic Government Services Fund to be 33 appropriated by the Legislature, in order to cut across state and 34 35 local governmental organizational structures and introduce 36 self-service models for citizens through state websites and other 37 electronic services. The committee shall promote economic development and efficient delivery of government services by 38 encouraging governmental and private sector entities to conduct 39 40 their business and transactions using electronic media. The Electronic Government Oversight Committee shall be composed of the 41 (a) the Executive Director of the Mississippi 42 following: 43 Department of Information Technology Services, who shall be the chairman of the committee; (b) the State Auditor; (c) the State 44 Treasurer; (d) the Secretary of State; (e) the Lieutenant 45 Governor; (f) the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and (g) 46 47 the Governor. The committee shall annually elect one (1) member to serve as vice chairman of the committee, who shall act as 48 chairman in the absence of the chairman. The committee shall meet 49 50 monthly or upon the call of the chairman, and shall make necessary reports and recommendations to the Legislature and the appropriate 51 52 agencies of state government. All agencies of state government shall cooperate with the committee in providing requested 53 54 information, and any E-Government task force previously organized 55 through the Department of Information Technology Services or the Office of the Governor shall work closely with and provide 56 57 information to the committee and shall report to the committee at its request. The Mississippi Department of Information Technology 58 59 Services shall provide administrative support for the committee. Nonlegislative members of the committee shall serve without 60 61 compensation.

62 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 63 and after July 1, 2001.
