SENATE BILL NO. 2422 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH IN THE STATE TREASURY THE ELECTRONIC 1 GOVERNMENT SERVICES FUND INTO WHICH SHALL BE DEPOSITED FUNDS 2 APPROPRIATED BY THE LEGISLATURE FOR DEVELOPING AND PROVIDING 3 ELECTRONIC GOVERNMENT SERVICES WITHIN THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI; TO 4 ESTABLISH AN ELECTRONIC GOVERNMENT SERVICES OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE TO 5 MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE EXPENDITURE OF SUCH FUNDS AND THE 6 DEVELOPMENT OF ELECTRONIC MEDIA GOVERNMENT SERVICES IN THE STATE; 7 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 10 SECTION 1. (1) There is established in the State Treasury the "Electronic Government Services Fund," into which shall be 11 12 deposited specific funds appropriated by the Legislature for 13 developing and providing electronic government services within the State of Mississippi. Any funds in the Electronic Government 14 15 Services Fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, but shall be available for expenditure in the 16 subsequent fiscal year. The funds in the Electronic Government 17 Fund shall be available for expenditure pursuant to specific 18 19 appropriation by the Legislature beginning in Fiscal Year 2002, to 20 the Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services, and shall be expended exclusively for developing and providing 21 22 electronic media government services within the State of 23 Mississippi.

(2) There is hereby established an Electronic Government 24 25 Oversight Committee to oversee the implementation of E-Government 26 and related technology initiatives. Duties of this committee 27 would include: (a) develop and make recommendations for all expenditures from the Electronic Government Services Fund to be 28 29 appropriated by the Legislature, in order to cut across state and \*SS26/R472SG\* S. 30 local governmental organizational structures; (b) address policy issues such as privacy, security, transaction fees and 31 32 accessibility; (c) review ongoing fiscal and operational 33 management and support of portal; (d) provide a mechanism for 34 gathering input from citizens, businesses and government entities; 35 (e) encourage self-service models for citizens through state 36 websites and other electronic services; and (f) promote economic development and efficient delivery of government services by 37 encouraging governmental and private sector entities to conduct 38 39 their business and transactions using electronic media. The 40 Electronic Government Oversight Committee shall be composed of the following: (a) the Executive Director of the Mississippi 41 42 Department of Information Technology Services, who shall be the chairman of the committee; (b) the State Auditor; (c) the State 43 Treasurer; (d) the Secretary of State; (e) the Executive Director 44 of the Department of Finance and Administration; (f) the Attorney 45 46 General; (g) the Chairman of the State Tax Commission; (h) the 47 Lieutenant Governor; (i) the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and (j) the Governor. The committee shall 48 49 annually elect one (1) member to serve as vice chairman of the 50 committee, who shall act as chairman in the absence of the 51 chairman. The committee shall meet monthly or upon the call of the chairman, and shall make necessary reports and recommendations 52 53 to the Legislature and the appropriate agencies of state 54 government. All agencies of state government shall cooperate with 55 the committee in providing requested information, and any 56 E-Government task force previously organized through the Department of Information Technology Services or the Office of the 57 Governor shall work closely with and provide information to the 58 committee and shall report to the committee at its request. 59 The Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services shall 60 61 provide administrative support for the committee. Nonlegislative members of the committee shall serve without compensation. 62 \*SS26/R472SG\*
