SENATE BILL NO. 2442

1 AN ACT TO CREATE SECTION 51-4-23.1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2 TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN PORTION OF THE TANGIPAHOA RIVER AS A STATE
3 SCENIC STREAM AND TO INCLUDE THAT PORTION IN THE STATE SCENIC
4 STREAMS STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section
7 51-4-23.1, Mississippi Code of 1972:

8 51-4-23.1. In accordance with Section 51-4-9, the Tangipahoa
9 River in Pike County beginning at U.S. Highway 51 and extending to
10 the Mississippi-Louisiana state line, which was designated as
11 eligible for nomination to the scenic streams stewardship program
12 under Section 51-4-21.1, is designated as a state scenic stream
13 and is included in the State Scenic Streams Stewardship Program.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
15 and after its passage.
