AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 83-39-27, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO REVISE PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES FOR BAIL BONDSMEN TO ALLOW 2 OUT-OF-STATE REAL PROPERTY TO BE USED AS SECURITY; AND FOR RELATED 3 4 PURPOSES BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 83-39-27, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 83-39-27. It is unlawful for a licensee to engage in any of 8 the following activities: 9 10 (a) Specify, suggest or advise the employment of any 11 particular attorney to represent his principal. (b) Pay a fee or rebate or give or promise to give 12 13 anything of value to a jailer, policeman, peace officer, clerk, deputy clerk, any other employee of any court, district attorney 14 15 or any of his employees or any person who has power to arrest or to hold any person in custody. 16 (c) Pay a fee or rebate or give anything of value to an 17 attorney in bail bond matters, except in defense of any act on a 18 bond, or as counsel to represent such bail agent, his agent or 19 20 employees. (d) Pay a fee or rebate or give or promise to give 21 22 anything of value to the person on whose bond he is surety. (e) Accept anything of value from a person on whose 23 bond he is surety, or from others on behalf of such person, except 24 25 the fee or premium on the bond, but the bail agent may accept collateral security or other indemnity. 26

27 (f) Coerce, suggest, aid and abet, offer promise of 28 favor or threaten any person on whose bond he is surety or offers 29 to become surety, to induce that person to commit any crime. 30 * * *
