- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-15-86, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO PROVIDE FOR THE LICENSING OF INDIVIDUAL COMMERCIAL CRABBERS;

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 49-15-86, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 49-15-86. (1) Each person catching or taking any saltwater
- 8 crabs in the waters of the State of Mississippi for commercial
- 9 purposes shall obtain a license from the commission and shall pay
- 10 the following annual * * * license fees:
- 11 (a) Resident fee of Seventy Dollars (\$70.00) for each
- 12 boat: * * *
- 13 (b) Nonresident * * * fee of One Hundred Sixty Dollars
- 14 <u>(\$160.00) for</u> each boat * * *;
- 15 (c) At least one (1) person on each boat must have a
- 16 <u>crab fishermen captain's license or be named as</u> an alternate on
- 17 the captain's license. The resident captain's license fee is Five
- 18 Dollars (\$5.00). The nonresident captain's license fee is Forty
- 19 Dollars (\$40.00); and
- 20 (d) If applicable, the commission shall establish
- 21 reciprocal nonresident fees according to Section 49-15-30.
- 22 (2) The commission may require a recreational crabber's
- 23 license for an administrative fee not to exceed Five Dollars
- 24 (\$5.00).
- 25 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after July 1, 2001.
