COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2527

AN ACT TO CREATE THE MULTI-MODAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT FUND; TO PROVIDE THAT MONEY IN SUCH FUND SHALL BE EXPENDED BY THE 3 MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AS PROVIDED FOR IN THIS ACT FOR THE IMPROVEMENTS OF AIRPORTS, PORTS, RAILROADS AND TRANSIT SYSTEMS IN MISSISSIPPI; TO FORM COMMITTEES FOR EACH MODE OF 6 TRANSPORTATION TO RECEIVE AND APPROVE APPLICATIONS FOR SUCH FUNDS; TO PROVIDE THAT A CERTAIN PERCENTAGE OF THE MONEY IN SUCH FUND 7 SHALL BE ALLOCATED TO EACH MODE OF TRANSPORTATION; TO PROVIDE THAT 8 5% OF THE MONEY IN THE FUND SHALL BE ALLOCATED AMONG THE VARIOUS 9 MODES OF TRANSPORTATION BY THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF 10 11 TRANSPORTATION BASED ON CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY SUCH DEPARTMENT; TO PROVIDE THAT 30% OF THE FUNDS ALLOCATED TO TRANSIT SYSTEMS 12 SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE COAST TRANSIT AUTHORITY AND 30% SHALL 13 BE ALLOCATED TO THE CITY OF JACKSON TRANSIT SYSTEM; TO REQUIRE 14 THAT A PORTION OF THE COST OF THE PROJECT OR PURPOSE FOR WHICH 15 FUNDING IS SOUGHT, NOT TO EXCEED 10%, SHALL BE FURNISHED BY THE 16 PORT, AIRPORT, RAILROAD OR TRANSIT SYSTEM SEEKING FUNDING; TO 17 CREATE A SPECIAL JOINT LEGISLATIVE MULTI-MODAL FUND COMMITTEE; 18 REQUIRE THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ANNUALLY 19 20 PREPARE A WRITTEN REPORT ON THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE FUND AND THE MULTI-MODAL TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS OF THE STATE AND TO SUBMIT SUCH 21 REPORT TO THE SPECIAL JOINT LEGISLATIVE MULTI-MODAL FUND 22 COMMITTEE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 2.3

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 25 SECTION 1. As used in this act:
- 26 (a) "Airport" means a publicly-owned airport in
- 27 Mississippi.
- 28 (b) "Fund" means the Multi-Modal Transportation
- 29 Improvement Fund created in Section 2 of this act.
- 30 (c) "MDA" means the Mississippi Development Authority.
- 31 (d) "MDOT" means the Mississippi Department of
- 32 Transportation.
- (e) "Modes" means airports, ports, railroads and
- 34 transit systems.
- 35 (f) "Port" means a public port in Mississippi.
- 36 (g) "Railroad" means a publicly-owned short line
- 37 railroad in Mississippi.

- 38 (h) "Transit system" means a public transit system in
- 39 Mississippi.
- 40 SECTION 2. There is established in the State Treasury a
- 41 special fund to be designated as the "Multi-Modal Transportation
- 42 Improvement Fund" into which shall be deposited such state funds
- 43 as may be designated for deposit therein. Unexpended amounts
- 44 remaining in the fund at the end of the state fiscal year shall
- 45 not lapse into the State General Fund, and any interest earned on
- 46 amounts in the fund shall be deposited to the credit of the fund.
- 47 Money in the fund shall be expended by MDOT as provided for in
- 48 this act for the improvement of airports, ports, railroads and
- 49 transit systems in Mississippi.
- 50 SECTION 3. (1) (a) There is hereby created the Multi-Modal
- 51 Fund Committee whose membership shall be as follows:
- 52 (i) The Executive Director of MDA, or his
- 53 designee;
- 54 (ii) The Executive Director of MDOT, or his

- (iii) Two (2) directors of ports appointed by the

- (vi) Two (2) representatives appointed by the

- 78 designee; and
- 79 (iv) The Executive Director of the Mississippi

- 81 (b) A majority of the membership of the committee shall
- 82 constitute a quorum. MDOT shall call meetings of the committee
- 83 and shall call a meeting for the purpose of reviewing and
- 84 approving applications as required in Section 4 of this act by not
- 85 later than August 1 of each fiscal year.
- 86 (3) (a) There is hereby created an Airport Multi-Modal Fund
- 87 Committee whose membership shall consist of:
- 88 (i) Five (5) directors of airports appointed by
- 89 the President of the Mississippi Airport Association, or their
- 90 designees, at least three (3) of whom shall represent airports
- 91 with commercial passenger service;
- 92 (ii) The Executive Director of MDA, or his
- 93 designee; and
- 94 (iii) The Executive Director of MDOT, or his
- 95 designee.
- 96 (b) A majority of the membership of the committee shall
- 97 constitute a quorum. MDOT shall call meetings of the committee
- 98 and shall call a meeting for the purpose of reviewing and
- 99 approving applications as required in Section 4 of this act by not

- 101 (4) (a) There is hereby created the Railroad Multi-Modal
- 102 Fund Committee whose membership shall consist of:

- 107 (iii) The Executive Director of MDOT, or his
- 108 designee.
- 109 (b) A majority of the membership of the committee shall
- 110 constitute a quorum. MDOT shall call meetings of the committee
- 111 and shall call a meeting for the purpose of reviewing and
- 112 approving applications as required in Section 4 of this act by not
- 113 later than August 1 of each fiscal year.
- 114 (5) (a) There is hereby created the Public Transit
- 115 Multi-Modal Fund Committee whose membership shall consist of:
- 116 (i) Three (3) directors of transit systems, other
- 117 than the Coast Transit Authority and the City of Jackson Transit
- 118 System serving the greater Jackson urbanized area, appointed by
- 119 the President of the Mississippi Public Transit Association, or
- 120 their designees;
- 121 (ii) The Executive Director of MDA, or his
- 122 designee; and
- 123 (iii) The Executive Director of MDOT, or his
- 124 designee.
- 125 (b) A majority of the membership of the committee shall
- 126 constitute a quorum. MDOT shall call meetings of the committee
- 127 and shall call a meeting for the purpose of reviewing and
- 128 approving applications as required in Section 4 of this act by not
- 129 later than August 1 of each fiscal year.
- SECTION 4. (1) During each state fiscal year, MDOT shall
- 131 distribute ninety-five percent (95%) of the money in the fund
- 132 among the various modes as follows:
- 133 (a) Thirty-eight percent (38%) shall be distributed to
- 134 ports;

- 135 (b) Thirty-four percent (34%) shall be distributed to 136 airports;
- 137 (c) Sixteen percent (16%) shall be distributed to 138 transit systems; and
- 139 (d) Twelve percent (12%) shall be distributed to 140 railroads.

The Railroad Multi-Modal Fund Committee shall decide 189 which applications shall be approved and the amount of funding for 190 each approved application based upon such criteria as it shall consider appropriate; provided, however, that no application shall 191 192 be approved or funds distributed pursuant to this act unless the expenditure of such funds shall be: 193
- 194 (a) Directly related to capital improvements or the
 195 rebuilding or rehabilitation of basic infrastructure and not for
 196 routine maintenance, administrative or operational expenses;
- 197 (b) For a project or use directly related to the 198 operation of the railroad in its modal role; and
- 199 (c) For a purpose outside the normal operating budget 200 of the railroad.

- 201 (6) (a) Thirty percent (30%) of the money allocated for 202 transit systems under subsection (1) of this section shall be 203 distributed by MDOT to Coast Transit Authority.
- (b) Thirty percent (30%) of the money allocated for transit systems under subsection (1) of this section shall be distributed by MDOT to the City of Jackson Transit System serving the greater Jackson urbanized area.
- The remainder of the money allocated for transit 208 (C) systems under subsection (1) of this section shall be distributed 209 by MDOT among other transit systems. In order to receive funds 210 211 under subsection (1) of this section, any such transit system shall file an application with MDOT describing how the money will 212 be used and shall provide such other information as MDOT may 213 Such applications shall be reviewed by the Public 214 require. The Public Transit 215 Multi-Modal Fund Committee shall decide which applications shall 216 be approved and the amount of funding for each approved 217 218 application based upon such criteria as it shall consider appropriate. 219
 - under this section, the port, airport, railroad or transit system shall be required to fund, from public or private sources, not more than ten percent (10%) of the total cost of the project or purpose for which the funds are to be spent. The percentage amount of such matching fund requirement shall be determined by MDOT. In addition to such other contributions and expenditures as may be considered acceptable by MDOT, in-kind contributions and expenditures for the following shall be credited toward the above matching requirement:

- (b) Personal property acquisition;
- (c) Real property acquisition, reclamation and related

In addition to such other expenditures as may be deemed 236 (8) 237 appropriate by MDOT or hereunder, money distributed from the fund 238 may be used to meet federal matching fund requirements and for pre-construction studies, planning and design; personal property 239 acquisition; real property acquisition, reclamation and related 240 relocation costs; professional services; and construction. 241 When approving applications under this section, the Port 242 Multi-Modal Fund Committee, the Airport Multi-Modal Fund 243 244 Committee, the Railroad Multi-Modal Fund Committee, the Public 245 Transit Multi-Modal Fund Committee, MDOT and the Multi-Modal Fund 246 Committee, respectively, are empowered to make commitments for 247 funding for up to three (3) consecutive state fiscal years, subject to the availability of money from the fund. 248 SECTION 5. (1) There is hereby created the Joint 249 Legislative Multi-Modal Fund Committee which shall consist of the 250 251 Chairman of the Senate Appropriations Committee, or his designee; the Chairman of the Senate Highways and Transportation Committee, 252 253 or his designee; the Chairman of the Senate Ports and Marine 254 Resources Committee, or his designee; the Chairman of the House 255 Appropriations Committee, or his designee; the Chairman of the House Transportation Committee, or his designee; the Chairman of 256 the House Conservation and Water Resources Committee, or his 257 258 designee; one (1) member of the Senate to be appointed by the Lieutenant Governor; and one (1) member of the House of 259 Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the House. 260 261 Administration of this act shall be subject to oversight by the Joint Legislative Multi-Modal Fund Committee. 262 263 MDOT shall annually prepare at its expense a written report on administration of the fund and the multi-modal 264 transportation systems of the state which shall include, without 265 266 limitation, a description of all applications for funding received

271	recommends to be funded through the fund. MDOT shall consult with
272	the committees established in Section 3 of this act when preparing
273	such report and provide sufficient copies of the report at no cost
274	to such committees. MDOT shall submit such report to the Joint
275	Legislative Multi-Modal Fund Committee by not later than September
276	1 of each year.
