## SENATE BILL NO. 2593

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-5-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CONFORM TO THE FEDERAL MIGRATORY BIRD TREATY ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 49-5-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 49-5-7. (1) No wild bird other than a game bird shall be
- 8 pursued, taken, wounded, killed, captured, possessed or exported
- 9 at any time, dead or alive. No part of the plumage, skin or body
- 10 of any bird protected by this section or of any birds coming from
- 11 without the state, the importation of which is prohibited into the
- 12 United States, shall be sold or had in possession for sale in this
- 13 state.
- No person shall molest, take or destroy or attempt to molest,
- 15 take or destroy the nests or eggs of any wild bird, or have such
- 16 nests or eggs in his possession, except under the authority of a
- 17 permit duly issued for scientific purposes.
- 18 (2) This section shall not apply to game birds for which
- 19 there is an open season under state law; birds, or parts thereof
- 20 collected or possessed under the authority of a certificate duly
- 21 issued for scientific purposes; or to the English sparrow, crow,
- 22 blackbird and starling or to the nests or eggs of such unprotected
- 23 birds. Nor shall anything contained in this section prohibit any
- 24 person on his own land or land under his control from killing or
- 25 destroying any English sparrow, crow, or \* \* \* blackbird or any
- 26 animal by nature destructive of gardens, crops or property of any

- 27 kind. This section shall not apply to introduced pheasants, which
- 28 are hereby classified as domestic fowls.
- 29 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 30 and after its passage.
