- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Section 35-1-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 9 10 amended as follows:
- 35-1-3. The State Veterans Affairs Board shall appoint, to 11
- serve at the will and pleasure of the board, \* \* \* an executive 12
- director, (who shall also serve as Executive Secretary of the 13
- State Veterans Affairs Board), a deputy director, individuals to 14
- 15 manage each of the agency's major functional areas and individuals
- to manage each of the state veterans homes. The executive 16
- director and deputy director shall be honorably discharged or 17
- honorably released veterans of the Armed Forces of the United 18
- States. The board may establish additional minimum qualifications 19
- 20 for agency positions.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 21
- 22 and after July 1, 2001.
