1	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 59-21-81, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF	1972
2	TO REQUIRE PERSONS ON PERSONAL WATERCRAFT TO WEAR PERSONAL	
3	FLOTATION DEVICE: AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.	

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 59-21-81, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 59-21-81. (1) Every vessel shall have on board a Coast
- 8 Guard approved personal flotation device for each person aboard
- 9 such vessel, and every person twelve (12) years or younger on
- 10 board a motorboat, sailboat, or vessel which measures less than
- 11 twenty-six (26) feet in length shall wear a type I, II, or III
- 12 Coast Guard approved personal flotation device while such
- 13 motorboat, sailboat, or vessel is underway. For the purpose of
- 14 this section "underway" shall mean at all times except when a
- 15 motorboat, sailboat, or vessel is anchored, moored, or aground.
- 16 Every vessel shall have lights during the hours of darkness, which
- 17 comply with all federal regulations applicable to vessels of its
- 18 classification. Such vessel shall not be operated unless in a
- 19 safe and seaworthy condition; the owner and operator shall employ
- 20 such safety devices as may be necessary for the safe operation of
- 21 such vessel, including an efficient natural or mechanical
- 22 ventilating system when necessary for safe operation. In addition
- 23 to the requirements imposed by this section, all vessels shall
- 24 comply with all federal regulations applicable to vessels of such
- 25 classification.
- 26 (2) For purposes of this subsection, "personal watercraft"
- 27 means a vessel which uses an inboard motor powering a water jet

- 28 pump and which is designed to be operated by a person sitting,
- 29 standing or kneeling on the vessel, rather than the conventional
- 30 manner of sitting or standing inside the vessel. A person shall
- 31 not operate a personal watercraft unless each person on board or
- 32 being towed behind is wearing a type I, type II or type III,
- 33 personal flotation device approved by the United States Coast
- 34 Guard.
- 35 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 36 and after July 1, 2001.
