SENATE BILL NO. 2666 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE SOUTHERN ARTS 1 AND ENTERTAINMENT CENTER IN MERIDIAN, MISSISSIPPI; TO AUTHORIZE 2 THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION TO ENTER INTO 3 AGREEMENTS WITH A NONPROFIT CORPORATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, 4 OPERATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE CENTER; TO AUTHORIZE THE 5 NONPROFIT CORPORATION TO RECEIVE FUNDS AND OTHER RESOURCES MADE 6 7 AVAILABLE FOR THE SOUTHERN ARTS AND ENTERTAINMENT CENTER; TO PROVIDE THAT NO STATE FUNDS OR STATE RESOURCES MAY BE USED FOR THE 8 CENTER UNLESS SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED BY THE LEGISLATURE FOR THAT 9 10 PURPOSE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 SECTION 1. (1) There is established the Southern Arts and 12 Entertainment Center ("center") to be housed in a facility located 13 14 within the corporate limits of Meridian, Mississippi. The purpose of the center shall be to provide an educational, entertaining and 15 16 interactive facility to illustrate the unique culture of the State of Mississippi or other southern states; to illustrate the 17 outstanding contributions of Mississippians to the arts and the 18 field of entertainment; and to provide family-oriented attractions 19 in the delivery of an educational experience to citizens of, and 20 visitors to, Mississippi. 21 (2) The center shall consist of a conference center, a 2.2 23 performing arts theater, an amphitheater and an artists' village. 24 The center shall conduct ongoing events such as induction into an arts and entertainment hall of fame, seminars, workshops and 25 26 demonstrations by guest artists.

(3) The duties and objectives of the center shall be: 27 28 (a) To stimulate and encourage throughout the state the 29 study and presentation of the performing, visual, and literary arts and public interest and participation therein; 30 *SS02/R855SG* S. B. No. 2666 G1/2 31 (b) To encourage participation in, appreciation of, and 32 education in the arts to meet the legitimate needs and aspirations 33 of persons in all parts of the state;

34 (c) To take such steps as may be necessary and
35 appropriate to encourage public interest in the cultural heritage
36 of Mississippi and the south to expand the state's cultural
37 resources, and to promote the use of art in state government's
38 activities and facilities; and

To encourage excellence and assist freedom of 39 (d) artistic expression essential for the well being of the arts. 40 41 The center is authorized to hold public hearings, to (4)enter into contracts within the limit of funds available therefor, 42 43 with individuals, organizations and institutions for services 44 furthering the objectives of the center's programs; to enter into contracts, within the limit of funds available therefor, with 45 local and regional associations for cooperative endeavors 46 47 furthering the objectives of the center's programs; to make and sign any agreements and to do and perform any acts that may be 48 necessary to carry out the purposes of this section. 49

50 The Department of Finance and Administration may enter (5) 51 into any agreement with a nonprofit corporation necessary for the 52 construction, operation and administration of the center. For the construction, operation and administration of the center, such 53 54 nonprofit corporation may receive and expend any funds made 55 available in any manner by public or private sources and may receive contributions and donations of land or other property and 56 57 other forms of financial assistance and property, equipment, 58 materials or manpower from persons, foundations, trust funds, 59 corporations, organizations, and other public or private sources to be expended and used in carrying out the mission of the center. 60 61 However, no state funds or other state resources may be used for 62 the center unless specifically authorized by the Legislature for

63 that purpose.
