SENATE BILL NO. 2709

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT AN ARREST WARRANT MAY BE ISSUED 1 AGAINST PEACE OFFICERS CHARGED WITH A CRIME ALLEGED TO HAVE 2 OCCURRED WHILE IN THE PERFORMANCE OF DUTY ONLY AFTER COMPLIANCE 3 WITH CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 6 SECTION 1. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this 7 section, before an arrest warrant shall be issued against any sworn peace officer within this state for a criminal act, whether 8 misdemeanor or felony, which is alleged to have occurred while 9 10 said officer was in the performance of the officer's official duties, a probable cause hearing shall be held before a circuit 11 court judge. The purpose of the hearing shall be to determine if 12 13 adequate probable cause exists for the issuance of a warrant. All parties testifying in these proceedings shall do so under oath. 14 15 The accused officer shall have the right to enter an appearance at the hearing, represented by legal counsel at his own expense, to 16 17 hear the accusations and evidence against him; he may present evidence or testify in his own behalf. 18

19 (2) Nothing in this section shall prohibit the issuance of 20 an arrest warrant by a circuit court judge upon presentation of 21 probable cause, without the holding of a probable cause hearing, 22 if adequate evidence is presented to satisfy the court that there 23 is a significant risk that the accused officer will flee the 24 court's jurisdiction or that the officer poses a threat to the 25 safety or well-being of the public.

26 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 27 and after July 1, 2001.
