COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 3031

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A DISTINCTIVE LICENSE 2 TAG FOR MEMBERS OF THE MISSISSIPPI STATE GUARD; TO ESTABLISH THE 3 FEE FOR ISSUANCE OF SUCH A TAG; TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A 4 DISTINCTIVE LICENSE TAG DISPLAYING NATIONAL ASSOCIATION FOR STOCK 5 CAR AUTO RACING THEMES; TO ESTABLISH THE FEE FOR ISSUANCE OF SUCH 6 A TAG; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a member 8 of the Mississippi State Guard who is a resident of this state, 9 10 upon payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law for private 11 carriers of passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial 12 motor vehicles, and upon payment of any additional fee required 13 under subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a 14 distinctive license tag for each motor vehicle registered in his 15 name identifying such person as a member of the Mississippi State 16 Guard. The distinctive license tags so issued shall be of a color 17 and design as may be designated by the State Tax Commission, shall 18 consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary 19 to distinguish each license tag and may, in the discretion of the 20 State Tax Commission, display the county name. 21

(2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 22 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms 23 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. Applicants for such 24 distinctive license tags shall present to the issuing official 25 proof of their membership in the Mississippi State Guard by 26 27 presentation of the official documents that certify such membership. 30 be retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State 31 Tax Commission on a monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. 32 The portion of the additional fee retained by the tax collector 33 shall be deposited into the county general fund.

34 (3) Any person who applies for a distinctive license tag 35 under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag applied 36 for under this section which shall be in addition to all other 37 taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a period of 38 time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established license tag 39 40 The additional fee is due and payable at the time the year. original application is made for a distinctive license tag under 41 42 this section and thereafter annually at the time of renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive license 43 If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive license 44 taq. tag, or if the owner retires or resigns from or otherwise vacates 45 his membership in the Mississippi State Guard, he must surrender 46 47 it to the local county tax collector.

The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the 48 (4) 49 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month, the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the 50 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of 51 distinctive license tags. The State Treasurer shall distribute an 52 amount equal to Sixteen Dollars and Twenty-five Cents (\$16.25) of 53 54 the additional fees collected from the issuance of such distinctive license tags under this section to the State General 55 Fund, and the remainder of such additional fees collected shall be 56 distributed by the State Treasurer to the credit of the State 57 Highway Fund to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, 58 59 construction or reconstruction of highways.

(5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the

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tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, which will expire the same month and year as the regular license tag.

In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license (6) 68 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and 69 70 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 71 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 72 73 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 74 75 for such replacement license tag, and the remainder shall be distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 76 distinctive license tags issued under this section. 77

78 SECTION 2. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle, upon payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and 79 80 registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, 81 82 and upon payment of any additional fee required under subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for 83 84 each motor vehicle registered in his name displaying National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing themes. The distinctive 85 license tags so issued shall be of a color and design as may be 86 87 designated by the State Tax Commission and shall depict such National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing themes as the State 88 89 Tax Commission shall determine appropriate. Such distinctive tags shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be 90 necessary to distinguish each license tag and may, in the 91 discretion of the State Tax Commission, display the county name. 92 Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 93 (2) 94 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the 95

No. 3031 01/SS01/R434CS PAGE 3 96 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less 97 three percent (3%) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, 98 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis 99 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional 100 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the 101 county general fund.

Any person who applies for a distinctive license tag 102 (3) under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount of 103 104 Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) for each distinctive license tag applied for under this section which shall be in addition to all 105 106 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 107 108 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the time the original application is made for a distinctive license 109 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 110 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 111 112 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive 113 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax collector. 114

(4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month, the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the total fees collected under this section from the issuance of distinctive license tags. The State Treasurer shall distribute such collections as follows:

(a) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
on the distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section
shall be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial
Burn Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-90.

(b) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
collected on the distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund

(c) The remainder of each additional fee collected on
the distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
be deposited to the credit of the State General Fund.

133 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 134 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the 135 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under 136 The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license 137 this section. 138 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, which will expire the same month and year as the regular license 139 140 taq.

In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license (6) 141 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and 142 143 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 144 145 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 146 147 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee for such replacement license tag, and the remainder shall be 148 149 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular distinctive license tags issued under this section. 150

151 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 152 and after July 1, 2001.
