7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
8	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
9	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
10	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Office of the
11	Secretary of State for the purpose of reimbursing counties for
12	costs incurred as a result of the holding of the statewide special
13	election for the purpose of selecting the official state flag for
14	the State of Mississippi, as authorized in House Bill No. 524,
15	2001 Regular Session, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001,
16	and ending June 30, 2002\$ 1,000,000.00.
17	SECTION 2. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
18	the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds
19	as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal
20	Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants
21	upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers
22	in the manner provided by law.
23	SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
24	and after its passage.
