3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
6	Treasury to the credit of the State Personnel Board for the
7	support and maintenance of the State Personnel Board for the
8	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002
9	\$ 4,590,607.00.
10	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
11	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
12	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
13	expenditure:

30	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
31	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
32	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
33	Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002
34	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
35	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the
36	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
37	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
38	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
39	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
10	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
11	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
12	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal
13	Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
14	the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
15	action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected
16	annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services"
17	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
18	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
19	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
50	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
51	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
52	the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.
53	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
54	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
55	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
56	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
57	SECTION 3. In addition to all other funds, the following

59	appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit

64	It is the intention of the Legislature that the State
65	Personnel Board Training Fund shall have the authority, should
66	additional funds become available, to escalate and expend those

70	The funds authorized under the provisions of this section
71	shall be held separate and apart from all other funds in the State

88	SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
89	State Personnel Board shall have the authority to escalate and
90	expend funds received from state agencies for reimbursement of
91	costs associated with the hiring of court reporters used in the
92	Employee Appeals Process. Such funds shall be received and
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expended under the rules and regulations of the Department of 93 94 Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 95 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 96 97 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 98 99 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer, and the State Fiscal 100 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 101

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from

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and after July 1, 2001.
