SENATE BILL NO. 3101

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE AID OF THE PUBLIC 1 COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR COLLEGES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI FOR 2 FISCAL YEAR 2002. 3 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. (1) The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the aid of the public 8 community and junior colleges for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... \$ 82,477,804.00. 9 10 (2) The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the 12 Education Enhancement Fund, not otherwise appropriated, for the aid of public community and junior colleges for the fiscal year 13 beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... 14 .....\$ 21,031,082.00. 15 16 (3) The money appropriated by this act shall be apportioned 17 as follows: 18 (a) The State Board for Community and Junior Colleges 19 shall distribute to each of the public community and junior 20 colleges, out of any money appropriated from the State General Fund, the sum of Four Hundred Twelve Thousand One Dollar 21 (\$412,001.00) and out of any money appropriated from the Education 22 23 Enhancement Fund, the sum of One Hundred Twelve Thousand Five 24 Hundred Eighty-six Dollars (\$112,586.00). 25 (b) The remainder of the appropriation for public 26 community and junior colleges shall be distributed in twelve (12) monthly installments beginning July 25, 2001, on the basis of the 27 \*SS05/A292\* S. 28 number of full-time academic and technical public community and 29 junior college students actually enrolled and in attendance on the 30 last day of the sixth week of the fall semester or its equivalent of the preceding year counting only those students who reside 31 32 within the State of Mississippi. Provided, however, that 33 technical students shall be weighted at 1.19 times that of academic students and Mississippi Virtual Community College shall 34 be weighted at 1.0 times that of academic students. 35

The Director of the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges shall visit each public community and junior college and shall determine, on the basis of an audit of students, who shall be counted in each college and shall certify the number to the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges.

If, pending determination of the full-time academic 41 enrollment of students at the public community and junior colleges 42 entitled to participate in this appropriation, as provided for in 43 44 this subsection, the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges 45 shall find and determine that any such public or community junior college does not have sufficient funds on hand for payment of the 46 47 necessary expenses of its operation for the period commencing July 1, 2001, until distribution of the funds appropriated hereby, 48 49 then, in that event, the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges is expressly authorized to make an advance to any such 50 51 public community or junior college or colleges not having 52 sufficient operating funds for such period from the funds 53 appropriated hereby; provided, however, that the amount of any 54 such advance to any one public community or junior college shall not exceed thirty-three percent (33%) of the amount of state 55 appropriated funds received by such public community or junior 56 college during the preceding fiscal year; and provided, further, 57 58 that the amount of any such advance shall be deducted from the pro 59 rata part of the funds appropriated hereby accruing to said public

60 community or junior college when enrollment has been ascertained 61 and distribution of funds is made.

62 (4) No part of the amount herein appropriated shall be used 63 by the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges for 64 administrative or other purposes except in the manner and to the 65 extent authorized in the act making an appropriation for the 66 expenses of the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges.

SECTION 2. (1) The following sum, or so much thereof as may 67 be necessary, is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the 68 69 State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support, 70 maintenance and equipping of vocational-technical departments in the public community and junior colleges which meet the 71 72 requirements for vocational-technical education departments for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002. 73 74 .....\$ 2,276,708.00.

75 (2) The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 76 necessary, is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the 77 Education Enhancement Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support, maintenance and equipping of vocational-technical 78 79 departments in the public community and junior colleges which meet the requirements for vocational-technical education departments 80 81 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002.....\$ 577,360.00. 82

(3) Such departments shall be open to students enrolled in the institutions, and to other students who may qualify for such courses, and to those meeting requirements for either civilian or veteran rehabilitation, whether or not enrolled in such institutions as regular students.

88 (4) Such funds shall be disbursed to such public community
89 and junior colleges on the basis of the full-time vocational
90 enrollment of each such public community and junior college as of
91 the last day of the sixth week of the fall semester or its

92 equivalent of the preceding year, counting only students who 93 reside within the State of Mississippi.

94 (5) No part of the funds hereby appropriated shall be spent95 for building or for regular academic instruction.

96 (6) The funds disbursed under the provisions of this act
97 shall be accounted for through the State Board for Community and
98 Junior Colleges.

99 SECTION 3. (1) The following sum, or so much thereof as may 100 be necessary, is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the 101 State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support of 102 part-time academic credit courses operated by public community and 103 junior colleges for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and 104 ending June 30, 2002...... \$ 11,345,373.00.

105 (2) The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 106 necessary, is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the 107 Education Enhancement Fund, not otherwise appropriated, for the 108 support of part-time academic credit courses operated by public 109 community and junior colleges for the fiscal year beginning 110 July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002...... \$ 2,877,122.00.

111 (3) These funds shall be disbursed by the State Board for 112 Community and Junior Colleges to such public community and junior 113 colleges as may qualify on the basis of the prior year full-time 114 equivalency of part-time and summer academic students, counting 115 only students who reside within the State of Mississippi.

116 SECTION 4. (1) The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 117 118 General Fund, not otherwise appropriated, to the State Board for 119 Community and Junior Colleges for the purposes of paying for nursing faculty supplement, in accordance with Section 37-129-1 et 120 seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, and aid to nursing education for 121 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002 122 .....\$ 4,436,806.00. 123

The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 124 (2) 125 necessary, is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the Education Enhancement Fund, not otherwise appropriated, to the 126 127 State Board for Community and Junior Colleges for the purpose of 128 paying for nursing faculty supplement, in accordance with Section 129 37-129-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, and aid to nursing 130 education for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... \$ 1,125,149.00. 131

SECTION 5. The following public community and junior colleges which qualify shall participate in the funds provided by Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of this act:

Coahoma Community College, Copiah-Lincoln Community College, 135 136 East Central Community College, East Mississippi Community 137 College, Hinds Community College District, Holmes Community College, Itawamba Community College, Jones County Junior College, 138 Meridian Community College, Mississippi Delta Community College, 139 140 Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College District, Northeast 141 Mississippi Community College, Northwest Mississippi Community College, Pearl River Community College, and Southwest Mississippi 142 143 Community College.

144 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 145 of the General Funds appropriated herein shall be expended for the 146 purpose of paying salaries, wages, and fringe benefits of any 147 public community and junior college employee who is serving as a 148 member of the State of Mississippi Legislature.

SECTION 7. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 149 150 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Board for 151 Community and Junior Colleges for the purposes of hiring nursing 152 153 and allied health teachers, awarding interest free nursing and 154 allied health student loans and providing instructional support 155 for the Rural Health Corps for the fiscal year beginning 156 July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... \$ 1,200,000.00. \*SS05/A292\* S. 157 The funds appropriated in this section shall be allocated as 158 follows:

(1) One-half (1/2) divided equally among the fifteen (15)public community and junior colleges.

161 (2) One-half (1/2) divided upon the basis of the number of 162 full-time academic, technical and vocational public community and 163 junior college students actually enrolled and in attendance on the 164 last day of the sixth week of the fall semester or its equivalent 165 of the preceding year counting only those students who reside 166 within the State of Mississippi.

167 The public community and junior colleges shall prepare and 168 make available to the Legislature and the Legislative Budget 169 Office an accounting of expenditures and program accomplishments 170 of the Rural Health Corps Program for each of the individual 171 community and junior colleges in a format and manner prescribed by 172 the Legislative Budget Office.

The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 173 SECTION 8. 174 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the aid of the public 175 176 community and junior colleges, to fund life and health insurance, for all employees of the public community and junior colleges for 177 178 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002. .....\$ 11,918,914.00. 179

The funds allocated in this section shall only be used to participate in the State and School Employees' Life and Health Insurance Plan. Any funds appropriated in these sections which are not expended during the fiscal year shall be carried forward for the same purposes during the next succeeding fiscal year.

SECTION 9. In addition to funds appropriated in Section 8, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Insurance Carryover Rund No. 3295, for the purpose of fully funding life and health insurance through the State and School Employees' Life and Health S. B. No. 3101 \*SS05/A292\* 01/SS05/A292

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190 Insurance Plan for all qualified community and junior college 191 employees, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending 192 June 30, 2002.....\$ 300,000.00.

193 SECTION 10. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 194 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 195 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 196 establishing and operating One-Stop Career Centers at each of the 197 public community and junior colleges for the fiscal year beginning 198 July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... \$ 4,500,000.00.

SECTION 11. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges for the purpose of defraying the cost of Sign Language Interpreter Training at the public community and junior colleges for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002...... \$ 179,050.00.

SECTION 12. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges for the purpose of defraying the cost of the Education Technology Program at the public community and junior colleges for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002...... \$ 3,599,160.00.

SECTION 13. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 213 214 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Education Enhancement Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the 215 216 State Board for Community and Junior Colleges for the purpose of defraying the cost of servicing the debt on bonds issued for the 217 Education Technology Program at the community and junior colleges 218 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending 219 220 June 30, 2002.....\$ 3,140,828.00.

The funds appropriated in this section shall be derived from Education Enhancement Funds deposited pursuant to Sections 223 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 14. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 (2), 2(2), 3 (2), and 4 (2), Twenty-five Million Six Hundred Ten Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$25,610,713.00) shall be derived from Education Enhancement Funds deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 15. A Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College Tuition (MPACT) program beneficiary shall be considered a Mississippi resident for the purposes of participating in this appropriation regardless of the beneficiary's residence on the date of enrollment, as set out in Mississippi Code Annotated, Section 37-155-5(d)(iii).

SECTION 16. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 276 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 277 278 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Board for 279 Community and Junior Colleges for the purpose of defraying the cost of the Golden Triangle Education Center for Manufacturing 280 281 Technology, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending 282 June 30, 2002.....\$ 100,000.00. 283 SECTION 18. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 284 necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the 285 Education Enhancement Fund No. 4302 in the State Treasury to the

credit of the Public Community and Junior Colleges, for the 286 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... 287 .....\$ 300,000.00. 288 289 SECTION 19. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 290 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 291 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 292 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 293 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 294 SECTION 20. This act shall take effect and be in force from 295 296 and after July 1, 2001.
