1 2	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
4	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
5	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
6	State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the
7	expenses of the Mississippi Development Authority for the fiscal
8	year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002
9	\$ 21,176,827.00.
10	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
11	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
12	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Development Authority or
13	the appropriate special fund for the purpose of defraying the
14	expenses incurred in the operation of the various divisions of the
15	authority for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending
16	June 30, 2002\$ 122,283,822.00.
17	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
18	Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall
19	be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
20	expenditure:

41	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
42	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
43	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
44	Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002
45	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
46	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the
47	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
48	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
49	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
50	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
51	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
52	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
53	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal
54	Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
55	the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
56	action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected
57	annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services"
58	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
59	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
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- 60 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 61 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 63 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 65 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 66 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 67 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 68 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the
- 69 amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall
- 70 be provided from the Motor Carrier Regulation Account to defray
- 71 the expenses of the Mississippi Development Authority in operating
- 72 the state welcome centers.
- 73 SECTION 5. The acceptance and expenditure of funds, and
- 74 interest on such funds, received from, or by virtue of consent or
- 75 other orders of or agreements involving any agency,
- 76 instrumentality, or judicial tribunal of any state or the United
- 77 States for petroleum price compliance and allocation which may
- 78 become available during the fiscal year for the support of the
- 79 Mississippi Development Authority or any programs sponsored under
- 80 the terms of the receipt of these funds are hereby authorized not
- 81 to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) and approved,
- 82 provided such receipts and expenditures are reported and otherwise
- 83 accounted for in accordance with Section 27-103-101 et seq., and
- 84 Section 27-104-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 85 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 86 Mississippi Development Authority is hereby authorized to
- 87 escalate, budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed
- 88 Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and
- 89 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a
- 90 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.
- 91 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 92 Mississippi Development Authority shall maintain complete

93	accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
94	funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
95	in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
96	Year 2001. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
97	the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2003 shall be
98	submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
99	and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
100	provided during the Fiscal Year 2002 budget request process.
101	SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the
102	amount of Four Million Four Hundred Sixty-two Thousand Dollars
103	(\$4,462,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
104	provided for the purpose of supporting Mississippi Tourism
105	Advertising and Promotion for Fiscal Year 2002. The expenditure
106	of funds authorized in this section shall be exempt from Section
107	25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.
108	SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the
109	amount of One Million Sixty-seven Thousand Dollars
110	(\$1,067,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
111	provided for the purpose of supporting, marketing, and
112	facilitating Mississippi business growth for Fiscal Year 2002.
113	The expenditure of funds authorized in this section shall be
114	exempt from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.
115	SECTION 10. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
116	Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of
117	the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
118	in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the
119	intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,
120	this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted
121	performance measures provided below:

L61	Institute for Technology Development, for the fiscal year
L62	beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002
L63	\$ 650,000.00.
L64	The funds appropriated under the provisions of this section
L65	are provided for the specific purpose of providing state funds for
L66	support of the Institute for Technology Development to equip,
L67	operate and maintain a post-graduate, integrated circuit design,
L68	engineering training program, known as ComPEET. The funds herein
L69	appropriated shall be held separate and apart from all other funds
L70	appropriated to the Mississippi Development Authority.
L71	SECTION 12. In addition to all other sums herein
L72	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
L73	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any special source funds
L74	not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of providing funds for
L75	the Institute of Technology Development, for the fiscal year
L76	beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002
L77	\$ 5,050,000.00.
L78	SECTION 13. In addition to all other sums herein
L79	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
L80	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
L81	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi
L82	Development Authority for the purpose of providing funds for
L83	Mississippi Technology, Incorporated, for the fiscal year
L84	beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002
L85	\$ 1,000,000.00.
L86	The funds appropriated under the provisions of this section
L87	are provided for the specific purpose of providing state funds for
L88	support of Mississippi Technology, Incorporated, to strengthen the
L89	business environment in Mississippi to spur the creation and
L90	growth of technology-based industries, thus creating many more
L91	high-paying jobs and a more diversified, competitive Mississippi
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192	economy. The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and
193	apart from all other funds appropriated to the Mississippi
194	Development Authority.
195	SECTION 14. In addition to all other sums herein
196	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
197	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any special source funds
198	not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of providing funds for
199	Mississippi Technology, Incorporated, for the fiscal year
200	beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002
201	\$ 150,000.00,
202	SECTION 15. In addition to all other sums herein
203	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
204	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
205	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi
206	Development Authority for the purpose of providing funds to
207	support the Stennis Space Center - Space Commerce
208	Initiative, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending
209	June 30, 2002\$ 1,500,000.00.
210	The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and
211	apart from all other funds appropriated to the Mississippi
212	Development Authority.
213	SECTION 16. In addition to all other sums herein
214	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
215	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any special source funds
216	not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of providing funds to
217	support the Stennis Space Center - Space Commerce Initiative, for
218	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002
219	\$ 4,000,000,00.
220	SECTION 17. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
221	Executive Director of the Mississippi Development Authority may
222	authorize increases in major objects of expenditure in total
223	amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the
224	appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure provided

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225	that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a
226	corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be
227	authorized which increase the major object of expenditure
228	"Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."
229	SECTION 18. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
230	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
231	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
232	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
233	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
234	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
235	SECTION 19. This act shall take effect and be in force from
236	and after July 1, 2001.
