SENATE BILL NO. 3115

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND
2 MAINTENANCE OF THE ALCORN STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL PROGRAMS
3 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and
8 maintenance of the Alcorn State University Agricultural Programs
9 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30,
10 2002..... \$ 4,739,758.00.

11 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special
13 source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available,
14 for the support and maintenance of the Alcorn State University
15 Agricultural Programs for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001,
16 and ending June 30, 2002..... \$ 472,207.00.

17 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2,
18 Twenty-two Thousand Two Hundred Seven Dollars (\$22,207.00) shall
19 be derived from funds in the Education Enhancement Fund deposited
20 pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of
21 1972.

22 SECTION 4. No general funds authorized to be expended herein
23 shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds
24 which are being used for salaries which are withdrawn and no
25 longer available.

26 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
27 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2003 shall be submitted to

28 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
29 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
30 during the Fiscal Year 2002 budget request process.

31 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
32 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
33 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
34 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
35 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
36 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

37 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from
38 and after July 1, 2001.
