SENATE BILL NO. 3120 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE 1 MISSISSIPPI EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY; AND FOR THE PURPOSE OF 2 ESTABLISHING A DISASTER RELIEF RESERVE FUND AND DEFRAYING THE 3 COSTS RELATED TO CERTAIN DISASTER ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS, FOR FISCAL 4 YEARS 2001 and 2002. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State 8 9 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Emergency Management 10 Agency in accordance with the provisions of Section 33-15-1 et 11 12 seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... \$ 13 752,184.00. 14 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 15 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi 16 17 Emergency Management Agency which is comprised of special source 18 funds collected by or otherwise available to the agency, for the support and maintenance of the agency for the fiscal year 19 beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... 20\$ 3,207,807.00. 21 22 SECTION 3. 46	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
47	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
48	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
49	Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002
50	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
51	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the
52	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
53	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
54	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
55	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
56	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
57	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
58	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal
59	Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
60	the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
61	action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected

67 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 68 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 2, Sixty-five Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-four Dollars (\$65,624.00) shall be derived from the Budget Contingency Fund created in Senate Bill No. 2680, Regular Session of 2001.

77 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 78 Director of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency may, upon 79 the request of a local public emergency management organization in an area which has suffered a natural disaster, supply equipment to 80 81 rural water associations to enable their continued operation when 82 the local emergency management organization determines that such 83 private entities provide services essential to the welfare of the 84 community.

85 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 86 Director of the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency shall 87 provide enhanced training to local governments, supervisors, 88 mayors, civil defense groups and municipal associations in 89 disaster management.

90 SECTION 7. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 91 necessary is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 92 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Emergency 93 Management Agency to be used to establish a special reserve fund

in the State Treasury for Disaster Relief, for the fiscal year 94 beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... 95 96\$ 65,726.00. 97 SECTION 8. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 98 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 99 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund 100 Nos. 3725 and 3728 for the purpose of defraying certain administrative expenses and the federal share of the cost of the 101 102 Disaster Relief Program, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... \$ 103 5,606,000.00. 104 SECTION 9. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 105 106 Treasury to the credit of the Emergency Management Agency Fund No. 107 372U for the purpose of defraying certain administrative expenses and the federal share of the cost of the Hazard Mitigation 108 109 Program, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending 110 June 30, 2002..... \$ 23,078,774.00. 111 SECTION 10. SECTION 20. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 191 192 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 193 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Emergency Management 194 Agency for the purpose of defraying certain administrative 195 expenses and the federal share of the cost of the Public 196 Assistance Program, the Individual and Family Grant Program and 197 the Hazard Mitigation Program resulting from the tornado disasters in February and March, 2001, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 198 199 2001, and ending June 30, 2002.....\$ 23,304,084.00.

SECTION 21. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 200 201 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 202 Treasury to the credit of the Budget Contingency Fund created in 203 Senate Bill No. 2680, Regular Session of 2001, to the Mississippi 204 Emergency Management Agency for the purpose of defraying certain 205 administrative expenses and the state share of the cost of the 206 Public Assistance Program, the Individual and Family Grant Program 207 and the Hazard Mitigation Program resulting from the tornado 208 disasters in February and March, 2001, for the fiscal year 209 beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... 210\$ 2,000,000.00.

SECTION 22. In addition to all other sums heretofore 211 212 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 213 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Budget Contingency Fund created in 214 215 Senate Bill No. 2680, Regular Session of 2001, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Emergency Management 216 217 Agency in accordance with Section 33-15-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001..... 218 219 21,875.00. 220 With the funds appropriated in this section, two (2)

221 permanent full-time positions are authorized.

222 SECTION 23. In addition to all other sums heretofore 223 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be S. B. With the funds appropriated in this section, six (6)time-limited full-time positions are authorized.

SECTION 24. The funds appropriated in Section 7 shall be expended only as provided in Sections 43-41-1 et seq. and 43-41-301 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, or for the purpose of matching federal funds in the event a disaster occurs within the state.

SECTION 25. The expenditure of the funds appropriated by 239 this act shall be under the direction of the Governor and shall be 240 241 paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, or the proper special funds, upon 242 243 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 244 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 245 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 246 SECTION 26. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2001. 247
