AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND 1 MAINTENANCE OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND TO 2 PAY THE EXPENSES OF COUNTIES FOR HOLDING STATE PRISONERS IN COUNTY 3 JAILS, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 8 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and maintenance of the Mississippi Department of Corrections for the 9 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... 10 11 .....\$ 253,678,888.00. 12 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 13 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi 14 15 Department of Corrections which is collected by or otherwise become available for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the 16 17 Department, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... \$ 14,744,448.00. 18 SECTION 3. Based on data provided by the 122 123 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 124 125 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 126 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. \*SS05/A550\* S. 127 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 128 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 129 130 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 131 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services" 132 133 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 134 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 135 136 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

137 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 138 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

143 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, 144 and authorized for expenditure in Section 3, it is the intention of the Legislature that any contractual service payments made by 145 146 the department to defray medical expenses for inmates shall be at 147 the currently established Medicaid reimbursement rate; however, if 148 hospital and medical providers will not contract at the Medicaid reimbursement rate, the Department of Corrections may enter into a 149 150 negotiated contract.

151 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, none shall be expended for personnel housing under the 152 153 jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections unless the department shall collect a reasonable rent, after a finding of 154 fact as to what is a reasonable rent, and/or the cost of utilities 155 156 furnished to said housing, except that the Superintendent of the 157 Central Mississippi Correctional Facility may be provided with a 158 housing expense allowance in lieu of being furnished with a 159 The Department of Corrections shall not pay for dwelling house. \*SS05/A550\* S. 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160 the installation or monthly service of any telephone installed in 161 a staff residence under its jurisdiction.

SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, and authorized for expenditure in Section 3, payment may be authorized for court ordered attorney fees and any accrued interest subject to the approval of the Office of the Attorney General.

167 SECTION 7. No part of the funds herein appropriated shall be 168 used for the purpose of returning escaped state convicts to the 169 State Penitentiary from a distance of over one hundred (100) miles 170 beyond the borders of the state, except upon approval of the 171 Governor in each specific case.

172 SECTION 8. None of the money herein appropriated shall be 173 paid to any person who by the provision of Section 47-5-47, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, is prohibited from being an 174 employee of the Mississippi Department of Corrections. 175 The State 176 Department of Finance and Administration shall at least annually 177 make a report to the Joint Legislative Committee on Performance Evaluation and Expenditure Review and to the Attorney General 178 179 stating the name of any person prohibited under the provisions of Section 47-5-47, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, from being 180 181 an employee of the Mississippi Department of Corrections who has during the preceding year received any money herein appropriated. 182 183 In the event that any such person prohibited as hereinabove 184 provided from receiving funds herein appropriated should receive any of said funds, the Attorney General shall immediately commence 185 186 action to recover the monies so paid to said person and to enjoin the further employment of said person at the Mississippi 187 Department of Corrections. 188

SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Commissioner of the Mississippi Department of Corrections may transfer between the divisions of Support, Medical Services, Parole Board, Farming Operations and Local Confinement, both funds S. B. No. 3123 \*SS05/A550\* 01/SS05/A550 PAGE 6

and positions not to exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the 193 194 authorized budgets in the aggregate. The Commissioner of the 195 Mississippi Department of Corrections shall submit written 196 justification for the transfer to the Legislative Budget Office 197 and the Department of Finance and Administration on or before the 198 fifteenth of the month prior to the effective date of the transfer. It is further the intention of the Legislature that no 199 transfer may be made under the provisions of this section to 200 201 increase or decrease the salaries category of any budget set forth 202 in the original appropriations made under this act, but may be 203 used to contract with counties to house state inmates in 204 facilities authorized by Section 47-5-931, Mississippi Code of 205 1972. It is further the intention of the Legislature that any 206 transfers made under the provisions of this paragraph shall be for 207 the removal of state inmates from county jails or of an emergency 208 nature.

209 SECTION 10. It is the intent of the Legislature that all 210 prisoners at Parchman shall work a minimum of eight (8) hours per 211 day, excluding prisoners with a physical disability or those 212 incarcerated in maximum security.

SECTION 11. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

259 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 260 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 261 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 262 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 263 SECTION 14. This act shall take effect and be in force from 264 and after July 1, 2001.
