## SENATE BILL NO. 3126

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 1 2 THE EXPENSES OF THE VETERANS AFFAIRS BOARD FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses and paying salaries of the Veterans Affairs 7 Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending 8 9 June 30, 2002..... \$ 2,955,095.00. 10 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 11 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Veterans Affairs 12 Board which is comprised of special source funds collected by or 13 14 otherwise available to the board, for the support and maintenance of said board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and 15 16 ending June 30, 2002..... \$ 20,416,262.00. 17 SECTION 3. With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 41 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 42 43 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 44 Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 45 46 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the 47 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 48 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 49 50 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 51 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 52 53 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 54 55 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 56 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services" 57 58 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 59 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation \*SS05/A731\* S. 60 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until61 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

62 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 63 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 68 69 Section 1, and authorized for expenditure in Section 3, funds in 70 the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) are provided to defray the cost of providing care to 71 72 indigent/low-income Mississippi veterans and the non-veteran surviving spouses of Mississippi veterans if the surviving spouse 73 74 was a resident of a state veterans home at the time of the 75 veteran's death and who, subsequent to the veteran's death, meets 76 the indigent/low-income criteria established by the State Veterans 77 Affairs Board, in the state veterans homes. It is the intention of the Legislature that the provision pertaining to use of 78 79 indigent/low-income surviving spouses be retroactive for any such period, prior to the effective date of this act, that a current 80 81 surviving spouse may have met the criteria. This section and its provisions shall be known and cited as the "Hilton R. 'Jack' Vance 82 Act of 1997." 83

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the funds appropriated in this act shall be used to pay Pharmacy Technicians.

87 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 88 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 89 90 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 91 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 92 \*SS05/A731\* S.
