32 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 33 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 34 Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002 35 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 36 37 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the 38 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 39 40 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 41 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 42 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 43 44 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal 45 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 46 47 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services" 48 49 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 50 51 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 52 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 53 54 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law. No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 55 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 56 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 57 58 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 59 SECTION 3. In addition to any other funds appropriated

70 SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated under the 71 provisions of Section 3 shall be requisitioned by the Employment Security Commission from the Unemployment Trust Fund maintained by 72 73 the Secretary of the Treasury of the United States as needed for 74 the payment of obligations incurred under this appropriation, and 75 such monies shall be deposited in the Employment Security 76 Administration Fund in accordance with the provisions of Section 77 71-5-457, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 5. In addition to any other funds appropriated herein, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of funds in the Special Employment Security Administration Fund to the Employment Security Commission for its use as provided in Section 71-5-114, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002...... \$2,075,000.00.

SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated under the provisions of Section 5 shall be requisitioned by the Employment Security Commission from the Special Employment Security Administration Fund as needed for the payment of obligations incurred under this appropriation, and such monies requisitioned shall be deposited in the Employment Security Administration Fund upon receipt.

The funds authorized in this section shall be under 98 the direction of the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property 99 Management.

100 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 101 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 102 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 103 104 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 105 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 106 107 and after July 1, 2001.
