AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD 1 OF CHIROPRACTIC EXAMINERS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002. 2 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of 6 Chiropractic Examiners, for the support of said Board for the 7 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... 8 9\$ 48,590.00. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 10 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law. 11 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 12 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 13 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 14 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 15 16 SECTION 2. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 17 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 18 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 19 20 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 21 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 22 23 and after July 1, 2001.
