30 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 31 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 32 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002 33 34 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the 35 36 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 37 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 38 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 39 40 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 41 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal 42 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 43 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 44 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 45 46 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services" 47 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 48 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 49 50 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 51 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law. 52 53 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 54 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 55 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this

57 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 58 of the funds appropriated in this act shall be authorized for the 59 purchase of surveillance equipment.

The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 61 62 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 63 64 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 65 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 66 and after July 1, 2001. 67
