SENATE BILL NO. 3206

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO JIMMY DALE BECK OF
2 MONTGOMERY COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 SECTION 1. The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Jimmy Dale Beck of Montgomery County,
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
7 conviction of the crime of accepting an offer of money to
8 influence an official act in Montgomery County, Mississippi, and
9 who was sentenced to serve five (5) years in the custody of the
10 Department of Corrections, three (3) years and six (6) months
11 suspended. He was placed under intensive supervision/house arrest
12 on July 12, 1996, and completed the program on July 12, 1997. He
13 then began serving his probation on July 9, 1997, and was
14 discharged on March 4, 1999. Since that time he has conducted
15 himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and
16 lawful manner.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
18 and after its passage.
