SENATE BILL NO. 3213

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO SHEILA MARIE  
2 MCDANIEL A/K/A SHELIA MARIE MCDANIEL OF ALCORN COUNTY,  
3 MISSISSIPPI.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 SECTION 1. The right of suffrage is hereby fully and  
6 completely restored to Sheila Marie McDaniel a/k/a Shelia Marie  
7 McDaniel of Alcorn County, Mississippi, who was disqualified as an  
8 elector as a result of her conviction of the crime of embezzlement  
9 in 1997 in Alcorn County, Mississippi. She was sentenced to sixty  
10 (60) months probation and discharged April 13, 2000. The  
11 Legislature has been reliably informed that she is now conducting  
12 herself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and  
13 lawful manner.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from  
15 and after its passage.
