- 8 WHEREAS, Mr. McCarty was a native of Clark County and was
- educated in the Enterprise public schools; he received his 9
- Bachelor's degree and Master's degree in Entomology from 10
- Mississippi State University; and 11
- WHEREAS, he began his agricultural career as a Pest 12
- 13 Management Consultant in DeSoto County and later assumed the
- position as Assistant County Extension Agent for Sharkey and 14
- Issaquena Counties; in 1967, he accepted a position with the State 15
- Plant Board as a District Entomologist; during his tenure with the 16
- board, which was renamed the Bureau of Plant Industry, he served 17
- 18 as Deputy Director in 1985 and Director in 1993; he served under
- two State Agriculture Commissioners, the late Jim Buck Ross and 19
- the present Commissioner, Lester Spell, Jr.; and 20
- 21 WHEREAS, Mississippi has lost a fine man in Robert McCarty;
- 22 he was committed in every way to doing an exemplary job for
- everyone associated with agriculture; and 23
- WHEREAS, he was active in many professional agricultural 24
- organizations and was the recipient of numerous awards for merit 25
- 26 and outstanding service, including the 1986 Merit Award for
- 27 Service from the Mississippi Entomological Association, the 1998

- 28 Distinguished Service Award from the Catfish Farmers of America
- 29 and Catfish Farmers of Mississippi, and the 1998 Distinguished
- 30 Service Award from the Mississippi Entomological Association; he
- 31 was a member of the First Baptist Church of Starkville; and
- 32 WHEREAS, he was a man who could be depended on in every way;
- 33 he was a wonderful father, and he took care of things, both at
- 34 work and at home; he was an extremely dedicated, loyal and hard-
- 35 working employee for the State of Mississippi; he loved his work
- 36 and it showed he was a role model and a leader for many people; he
- 37 was a constant and steady man who led by example; he was a mentor;
- 38 and he will be missed; and
- 39 WHEREAS, it is with much sadness that we note the passing of
- 40 this dedicated public servant who has served as a role model and
- 41 brought honor to the State of Mississippi:
