| 1 2 3 4 | A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE NATIONAL PROCLAMATION OF NATIONAL HEART FAILURE AWARENESS WEEK AND URGING THE ADOPTION OF CERTAIN MEDICAL PRACTICE AND PAYOR REIMBURSEMENT GUIDELINES REGARDING CONGESTIVE HEART FAILURE. |
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| 5 | WHEREAS, each year there are 550,000 new cases of congestive |
| 6 | heart failure diagnosed, with 200,000 deaths and one million |
| 7 | hospitalizations per year due to the disease; and |
| 8 | WHEREAS, congestive heart failure is the leading cause of |
| 9 | hospitalization in patients over the age of 65; and |
| 10 | WHEREAS, congestive heart failure patients with the most |
| 11 | severe symptoms have approximately 50% one-year survival rate and |
| 12 | half of the patients with even mild disease die within 5 years; |
| 13 | and |
| 14 | WHEREAS, the vast majority of patients are not diagnosed |
| 15 | until late in the course of disease; and |
| 16 | WHEREAS, a conservative estimate of annual U.S. health |
| 17 | expenditures for congestive heart failure is in excess of Ten |
| 18 | Billion Dollars with the largest portion, Eight Billion Dollars, |
| 19 | of this expenditure for the cost of hospitalizations; and |
| 20 | WHEREAS, although current treatment guidelines recommend that |
| 21 | approximately 80% of heart failure patients receive ACE inhibitors |
| 22 | in combination with beta blockers to extend life and reduce costly |
| 23 | hospitalizations but only 45% of patients are treated with ACE |
| 24 | inhibitors and 20% of patients receive beta blockers; and |
| 25 | WHEREAS, the primary goals of the "National Heart Failure |
| 26 | Awareness Week" are: (1) to promote research related to all |
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aspects of heart failure and provide a forum for presentation of

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- 28 that research; (2) to educate heart failure caregivers and
- 29 patients through programs, publications, and other media allowing
- 30 for more effective treatment and diagnosis of heart failure; and
- 31 (3) to enhance the quality and duration of life for those with
- 32 heart failure:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 34 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
- 35 we do hereby endorse the national proclamation of "National Heart
- 36 Failure Awareness Week."
- 37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the State of Mississippi
- 38 endorses the National Proclamation of National Heart Failure
- 39 Awareness week.
- 40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the State Board of Health
- 41 transmit the treatment guidelines for congestive heart failure
- 42 published by the Heart Failure Society of America, Inc., to the
- 43 State Medical Licensure Board while urging their adoption of these
- 44 guidelines in their practice.
- 45 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That physicians and payers should be
- 46 encouraged to administer or provide reimbursement for
- 47 echocardiograms to all patients over 50 years of age with a
- 48 history of heart disease and begin appropriate treatment as early
- 49 as possible.
- 50 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That physicians and payers should be
- 51 encouraged to prescribe or provide reimbursement for the standard
- 52 of care for congestive heart failure, including FDA approved beta
- 53 blockers and ACE inhibitors, as well as other therapies that have
- 54 been shown to reduce the mortality and morbidity associated with
- 55 congestive heart failure.
- 56 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Legislature endorses the
- 57 inclusion of the latest treatment advances for congestive heart
- 58 failure in the curriculum of the University Medical Center.
- 59 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution be transmitted
- 60 to the State Board of Health and the Board of Trustees of State

- 61 Institutions of Higher Learning for appropriate action, and that
- 62 copies be made available to the Capitol Press Corps.
