- 2 ADDITIONAL FUNDS TO ASSIST THE ELDERLY AND LOW-INCOME CITIZENS OF
- 3 THIS STATE WITH THEIR NATURAL GAS BILLS, AND TO TAKE ANY
- 4 REGULATORY ACTION NECESSARY TO ADDRESS THE DRAMATIC INCREASE IN
- 5 THE PRICE OF NATURAL GAS.
- 6 WHEREAS, natural gas is an essential commodity which is used
- 7 by individuals primarily for cooking and heating; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the demand for natural gas has increased in recent
- 9 years because of a number of factors, including colder winter
- 10 temperatures, the start of operations at new gas-fired electric
- 11 power generating units, and increased new home construction, which
- 12 in turn increases the use of natural gas for cooking and heating;
- 13 and
- 14 WHEREAS, the supply of natural gas has remained fairly flat
- 15 over the past few years and although exploration and development
- 16 of natural gas has increased this past year, the increase has yet
- 17 to be reflected in the market; and
- 18 WHEREAS, because of a lag in supply in response to a recent
- 19 surge in demand, the market has reacted by increasing the average
- 20 wellhead price for natural gas; and
- 21 WHEREAS, residential customers of natural gas are expected to
- 22 pay as much as 40% more on their natural gas bills this winter as
- 23 compared to last winter, in response to the increased wellhead
- 24 price for natural gas; and
- 25 WHEREAS, the rapid rise in natural gas prices over the last
- 26 few months has raised concerns about the effect those increases
- 27 will have on citizens of this state, particularly the elderly and

- 28 those with a low income who are unable to absorb the increased
- 29 costs because of income and budget constraints; and
- 30 WHEREAS, the dramatic increase in natural gas prices could
- 31 potentially affect the health and comfort of Mississippi citizens,
- 32 and in some cases could even be life threatening, if persons are
- 33 disconnected this winter because they are unable to pay their
- 34 natural gas utility bill; and
- 35 WHEREAS, while there are currently some government and
- 36 utility provided low-income energy assistance programs available
- 37 to persons on a limited budget, because of the extreme situation
- 38 citizens of this state are facing, those programs will probably
- 39 not be able to assist everyone who will be in need; and
- 40 WHEREAS, Mississippi recognizes the need to provide
- 41 additional financial assistance to the elderly and low-income
- 42 citizens of this state to help them pay for the higher cost of
- 43 natural gas; and
- 44 WHEREAS, Mississippi further recognizes that additional
- 45 regulations and investigative hearings by the Federal Energy
- 46 Regulatory Commission may be needed to solve this natural gas
- 47 dilemma:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 49 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
- 50 we do hereby memorialize Congress to appropriate additional funds
- 51 to assist the elderly and low-income citizens of this state with
- 52 their natural gas bills, and to take any regulatory action
- 53 necessary to address the dramatic increase in the price of natural
- 54 gas.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be
- 56 furnished to President George W. Bush; the Mississippi
- 57 congressional delegation; Curt Hebert, Jr., Chairman of the
- 58 Federal Energy Regulatory Commission; and be presented to the
- 59 Capitol Press Corps.
