15 outstanding and worthwhile Mississippi Humanities Council
16 programs, including the Mississippi Chautauqua and the Prime Time
17 Family Reading Program; and

18 WHEREAS, Dr. Elizabeth Sarcone has been recognized by the
19 Mississippi Humanities Council as the 2001 Humanities Educator of
20 the Year for the State of Mississippi:
