- 6 National Junior College Athletic Association Women's Basketball
- 7 Hall of Fame on March 19, 2001, in Salina, Kansas, in conjunction
- 8 with the national Junior College Women's Basketball Tournament;

- 10 WHEREAS, Sue Ross was born and reared in Gautier,
- 11 Mississippi, the daughter of Odom and Pansy Ross (deceased),
- 12 attended Gautier Grammar School, and graduated from Pascagoula
- 13 High School in 1953, where she played varsity basketball, received
- 14 a work scholarship to attend Perkinston Junior College
- 15 (Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College) where she earned her
- 16 A.S. Degree, received a B.S. Degree from Mississippi Southern
- 17 College (University of Southern Mississippi) in Health, Physical
- 18 Education & Recreation in 1957 and received an M.S. Degree in
- 19 Health, Physical Education & Recreation in 1964; and
- WHEREAS, she began her teaching career in 1957, teaching
- 21 health and physical education at Hartman Junior High School at
- 22 Houston, and returned to M.G.C.C.C. in 1960 as a health and
- 23 physical education teacher; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Ms. Ross retired from M.G.C.C.C. 31 years later with
- 25 many wonderful memories and experiences, including coaching the
- 26 following championship teams: Volleyball--MAEACW State
- 27 Championship 1969; Women's Tennis--Mississippi Junior College

- 28 Conference Championships 1967/1968; Women's Basketball--MAEACW
- 29 Championship 1968; MAEACW Junior College Division Championship and
- 30 Overall State Championship 1971; MAEACW State Junior College
- 31 Championship 1972; AIAW National Invitational Junior College
- 32 Tournament at Delta College, Bay City, Michigan, 1973; Runner-up
- 33 in AIAW National Junior College Tournament at Delta College, Bay
- 34 City, Michigan; Mississippi Association of Junior Colleges South
- 35 Division Championship, Mississippi Association of Junior Colleges
- 36 Overall State Championship, the NJCAA Region 7 Championship in
- 37 Cleveland, Tennessee, and the consolation bracket of the NJCAA
- 38 National Tournament in Overland Park, Kansas, 1977; and
- 39 WHEREAS, from 1967 through 1979, her basketball coaching
- 40 record was 184 wins and 85 losses; and
- 41 WHEREAS, Ms. Ross served as Representative for District 3 of
- 42 the AIAW from 1971 through 1975; and
- WHEREAS, she was a member of the selection committee for the
- 44 1974 U.S. World University Games Women's Basketball Team and
- 45 Coaches; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Ross served as an assistant women's basketball
- 47 coach for the South Team at the first National Sports Festival
- 48 held in Colorado Springs, Colorado; and
- 49 WHEREAS, she served as an NJCAA representative to the ABAUSA,
- 50 which selected players and coaches for national, international and
- 51 Olympic women's basketball competition; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Ross served on the NJCAA Women's Basketball
- 53 Committee, Women's Tennis Committee and the Slow-pitch Softball
- 54 Committee; and
- 55 WHEREAS, in 1979 she transferred to the Mississippi Gulf
- 56 Coast Community College Jackson County Campus as Intramural
- 57 Director and Instructor of Health and Physical Education classes
- 58 and retired in 1991 in her hometown of Gautier; and

- 59 WHEREAS, in 1999 Ms. Ross was inducted as an inaugural member
- 60 of the Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College Athletic Hall of
- 61 Fame; and
- WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize the
- 63 accomplishments and career of this Mississippian who has brought
- 64 honor to her community, her college and to the State of
- 65 Mississippi:
