SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 588

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE LIFE OF FORMER
2 REPRESENTATIVE BENJAMIN F. CAMMACK, JR., OF COPIAH COUNTY,
3 MISSISSIPPI, AND EXPRESSING THE SYMPATHY OF THE LEGISLATURE.

4 WHEREAS, former Representative and World War II Veteran
5 Benjamin F. Cammack, Jr., 92, of the Rockport Community in Copiah
6 County, Mississippi, passed away on February 24, 2001; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Cammack was a life-long resident of Copiah
8 County; his family had lived for the last three years in the
9 Rockport Community; and

10 WHEREAS, he was a member of the Providence United Methodist
11 Church; he served as a member of the Mississippi House of
12 Representatives for two terms; he was a past President of the Farm
13 Bureau; and

14 WHEREAS, he served on the Board of Directors of Southern Pine
15 for many years as Vice President; he was instrumental in helping
16 get electric power to many parts of Copiah County; he was a member
17 of the Cattleman's Association; he operated a cotton gin for many
18 decades in Rockport; he served in the Army during World War II;

20 WHEREAS, he is survived by his wife, Ruth Cammack, of
21 Hazlehurst, Mississippi; and

22 WHEREAS, it is with great respect that we note the passing of
23 this dedicated public servant and World War II Veteran whose
24 contributions to his community, his church and to the State of
25 Mississippi serve as a model to all citizens:

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
27 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That

28 we do hereby commend the life of former Representative Benjamin F.
29 Cammack, Jr., of Copiah County, Mississippi, and express the
30 sympathy of the Legislature to his family on his passing.
