Burkes; and WHEREAS, Commissioner Burkes, a Republican from Mississippi, 9 10 was nominated to the Surface Transportation Board by President Clinton and was confirmed by the Senate on February 22, 1999, to 11 12 complete a five-year term expiring December 31, 2002; and WHEREAS, at the time of his appointment, Commissioner Burkes 13 had served as the Mississippi Transportation Commissioner of the 14 Central District since March 1989. Before being elected 15 Transportation Commissioner, he served 14 years in the Mississippi 16 Legislature, four years in the House of Representatives and ten 17 18 years in the Senate. He served on the Highways and Transportation 19 Committees for all 14 years of his legislative experience. He is 20 a former member of the faculty at Hinds Community College; and WHEREAS, a long-time Air Force and Air National Guard pilot, 21 he has flown eight different Air Force aircraft for 7,000 flying 22 23 hours and is a retired Major General from the Mississippi Air 24 National Guard. He is a former president of the National Guard Association of Mississippi and is a life member of the American 25 26 Legion and Veterans of Foreign Wars; and
