REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1615: Appropriation; Governors Office - Division of Medicaid.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 8 9 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Governor's Office 10 - Division of Medicaid for the purpose of providing medical 11 assistance under the Mississippi Medicaid Law and defraying the expenses of the administration of such law, as provided in 12 13 Section 43-13-101 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the 14 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002....

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature 8 that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds 9 required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do 10 not exceed Fiscal Year 2002 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless 11 programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget 12 by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative 13 Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the 14 projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance 15 with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency 16 head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected 17 annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal 18 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State 19 20 Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal 21 Year 2002 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then 22 only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the 23 appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board 24 until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 25

26 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the 27 terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

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SECTION 6. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget
