REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 2511: Highways; designate a portion of MS Highway 25 as Purple Heart Memorial Drive.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 7 SECTION 1. (1) That portion of Mississippi Highway 25
- 8 beginning at the Hinds/Rankin County line and extending
- 9 northeasterly to the Leake/Winston County line shall be known and
- 10 designated as "Military Order of the Purple Heart Drive."
- 11 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
- 12 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching such highway.
- SECTION 2. Section 65-3-71.57, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 14 amended as follows:
- 15 65-3-71.57. (1) That portion of U.S. Interstate 20 within
- 16 the State of Mississippi * * * shall be known as the "31st
- 17 Infantry Division Memorial Highway."
- 18 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
- 19 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching such highway.
- 20 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after July 1, 2001.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN PORTION OF MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY 2 25 AS "MILITARY ORDER OF THE PURPLE HEART DRIVE"; TO AMEND SECTION

- 65-3-71.57, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DESIGNATE ALL OF U.S. INTERSTATE 20 WITHIN THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI AS THE 31ST INFANTRY DIVISION MEMORIAL HIGHWAY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
