REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3087: Appropriation; Finance & Admin. Consol.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof 5 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the 6 7 expenses of the Department of Finance and Administration for the 8 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001 and ending June 30, 2002 \$ 9 13,467,459.00. 10 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 11 12 Treasury to the credit of the Department of Finance and

Administration for the purpose of defraying the expenses incurred in the operation of the various offices of the department for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001 and ending June 30, 2002....\$ 16,384,724.00. SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized: AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:

20Permanent:Full Time36821Part Time222Time-Limited:Full Time123Part Time0

24 Provided that a report based on expenditures incurred during 25 the current and immediate-past fiscal years shall be provided to 26 each regularly scheduled legislative session. This report should 27 reflect expenditures as a result of the operation of the Robert E. Lee Building, the Woolfolk State Office Building, the Gartin 28 29 and Sillers Buildings, the Capitol Buildings, the Central High School Building, the 301 Building and other state buildings, and 30 31 this report should contain any steps taken to reduce operating 32 costs.

33 It is also the intention of the Legislature that no
34 state-owned aircraft shall be utilized by any person except for

35 official business only.

36 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions 37 of Section 2, the amount of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be expended for 38 39 premium payments for flood insurance on state-owned facilities. However, no such premium shall be paid until reviewed and 40 41 approved by the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property 42 Management. Said payments are to be made from accrued interest 43 earnings from loans under the Disaster Assistance Program. 44 SECTION 5. In addition to all other sums herein 45 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 46 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 47 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Tort Claims Fund 48 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Tort Claims 49 Board in the administration of the Tort Claims Act for the fiscal 50 year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... 51\$ 12,234,005.00. SECTION 6. With the funds appropriated under the provisions 52 53 of Section 5, the following positions are authorized: 54 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: Full Time 55 Permanent: 6 56 Part Time 0

57 Time-Limited: Full Time 0 58 Part Time 0

59 SECTION 7. With the funds herein appropriated, it is the 60 intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's 61 responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not 62 63 exceed Fiscal Year 2002 funds appropriated for that purpose, 64 unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal 65 Year 2003 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data 66 provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel 67 Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to 68 fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the 69 provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 70 agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases 71 this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 72 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at 73 the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board 74 determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause 75 the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal 76 Year 2002 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when 77 annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected 78 annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be

79 processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the 80 requirements of this provision are met.

81 Any transfers within each specific budget or escalations 82 shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and 83 procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

88 SECTION 8. The Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real 89 Property Management of the Office of General Services is hereby 90 expressly authorized and empowered to receive, budget and expend 91 any state, local or other source funds designated for 92 supplemental funding of construction and/or repairs and 93 renovation projects.

94 SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the 95 following amounts are authorized to be spent out of the Statewide 96 Cost Allocation Fund No. 3143 by the Department of Finance and 97 Administration:

98 (a) One Hundred Sixty-six Thousand Two Hundred Fifty
99 Dollars (\$166,250.00) for the purpose of defraying computer
100 expenses.

(b) Six Hundred Twenty-eight Thousand One Hundred Ninety-four Dollars (\$628,194.00) for the purpose of defraying the cost of the acquisition, development and implementation of the Statewide Automated Accounting System.

105 (c) One Hundred Eighty-three Thousand Four Hundred 106 Dollars (\$183,400.00) for implementation and operation of an 107 imaging/electronic processing system.

SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One Hundred Sixty-five Thousand Dollars (\$165,000.00) is authorized to be spent out of the Local Disaster Loan Fund No. 3144 by the Department of Finance and Administration for the purpose of defraying the cost of the Air Transport Services.

113 SECTION 11. The Office of Capitol Facilities, Department of 114 Finance and Administration, is hereby expressly authorized and 115 empowered to receive funds from state agencies for the rent of 116 office space in the Eldon Bolton Office Building in Biloxi, 117 Mississippi, and the State Service Center in Hattiesburg, Mississippi. The Office of Capitol Facilities is further 118 119 authorized and empowered to budget and expend any such funds received to operate and maintain, and up to Five Dollars (\$5.00) 120 per square foot of rental receipts to finish tenant space, in the 121 122 Eldon Bolton Office Building in Biloxi, Mississippi, and the

123 State Service Center in Hattiesburg, Mississippi, as state office 124 buildings. Monies received for rent of such office space are to 125 be deposited in a special fund in the State Treasury. Any funds 126 on hand at the end of the fiscal year shall lapse into the State 127 General Fund.

128 SECTION 12. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 129 Department of Finance and Administration shall maintain complete 130 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of 131 all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall 132 be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for 133 Fiscal Year 2001. It is further the intention of the Legislature 134 that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2003 shall be 135 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 136 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 137 provided during the Fiscal Year 2002 budget request process.

SECTION 13. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Department of Finance and Administration is hereby authorized to escalate, budget and expend funds from the Statewide Cost Allocation Fund in an amount not to exceed Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$800,000.00) in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds, for the purpose 145 of paying increased utility costs for the Capitol Complex for 146 Fiscal Year 2002.

147 SECTION 14. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money collected 148 149 into the Statewide Cost Allocation Fund during Fiscal Year 2001 150 not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of authorizing the 151 expenditure of these funds, originally authorized for specific 152 purposes in Senate Bill No. 3242, Regular Session of 2000, and in 153 Senate Bill No. 3059, Regular Session of 2001, to be used for any 154 purpose deemed necessary for the operation of the Department of 155 Finance and Administration for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 156 2001, and ending June 30, 2002.....\$ 500,000.00. 157 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the

158 provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended 159 exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2001.

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	SECTION 15. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State
6	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of Finance and
7	Administration for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of State
8	General Funds, as authorized in Senate Bill No. 3242, Regular Session of
9	2000, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002\$ 300,000.0
10	Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the provisions of
11	this section, in no event shall the amount expended exceed the unexpended
12	balance as of June 30, 2001.
13	SECTION 16. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the
14	State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the
15	proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the
16	State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants
17	upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the
18	manner provided by law.
19	SECTION 17. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after
20	July 1, 2001.
