#### REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

### MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL: S. B. No. 3089: Appropriation; Information Technology Services.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any 7 special source funds which are collected by or otherwise become 8 available for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the 9 Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services, for 10 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002 11 .....\$ 32,089,596.00. 12 SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions 13 of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature 6 that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds 7 required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do 8 not exceed Fiscal Year 2002 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless 9 programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget 10 by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative 11 Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the 12 projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance 13 with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency 14 head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected 15 annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal 16 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State 17 Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which 18 would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal 19 Year 2002 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then 20 only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the 21 appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board 22 until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 23

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

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SECTION 3. In order to offset the cost of publishing the annual

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Mississippi Official Telephone Directory, the Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, in its discretion, to offer for advertising purposes, pages to be included in said Directory, to accept bids, and to let contracts for said pages. The contracts for said advertising purposes shall be let for definite periods not to exceed two (2) years.

It shall be the duty of the Mississippi Department of Information 37 Technology Services, if it is desired that advertising shall be used, to 38 approve all proposed advertising submitted for use within such annual 39 Mississippi Official Telephone Directory. The department is hereby 40 authorized, empowered and directed, in its discretion, to reject any and all 41 bids submitted, and if all bids are rejected, the authority may negotiate a 42 contract within the limitations of the specifications so long as the terms of 43 any such negotiated contract are equal to or better than the comparable 44 terms submitted by the lowest and best bidder. No sectarian, un-American, 45 political, partisan or immoral advertisement, as determined solely by the 46 authority or its successor, shall be accepted. 47

All moneys derived from sale of such advertising shall be deposited in
 the appropriate special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the
 Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services.

SECTION 4. The Mississippi Department of Information Technology
 Services is hereby authorized to receive additional funds from any state
 agency or other source, including one hundred percent (100%) general-fund
 agencies, for the purpose of providing data processing or
 telecommunications services to any governmental organization contracting
 with the Mississippi Department of Information Technology Services for
 such services. The Mississippi Department of Information Technology

Services is further authorized to escalate an amount not to exceed One
Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) and to increase, up to a maximum of twenty
(20) additional positions, the number of authorized positions listed in this act
in order to provide the required data processing or telecommunications
services for such governmental organizations, under the rules and
regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration.

64 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the 65 State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the 66 proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the 67 State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants 68 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the 69 manner provided by law.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after
July 1, 2001.
