are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of

this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

- 7 received from state agencies for reimbursement of costs associated with the
- 8 hiring of court reporters used in the Employee Appeals Process. Such
- 9 funds shall be received and expended under the rules and regulations of the
- Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the
- escalation of federal funds.
- SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the

 State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the

 proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the

 State Fiscal Officer, and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants

 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the

 manner provided by law.
- SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2001.
