We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

- S. B. No. 3095: Appropriation; Governor's Office and Mansion.
  - We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:
  - 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
  - 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
- 8 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for expenses of the
- 9 Executive Department, being the Governor's office and staff, for
- 10 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002,
- 11 .....\$ 2,235,616.00.
- 12 SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 13 of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:

# Part Time 0

Any escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2001.
