## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3100: Appropriation; Jr. Colleges - Admin.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
- 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
- 8 defraying the administrative expenses of the State Board for
- 9 Community and Junior Colleges for the fiscal year beginning
- 10 July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002...... \$ 7,085,902.00.
- 11 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
- 13 Treasury to the credit of the State Board for Community and

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14	Junior Colleges, for the purpose of defraying the administrative	
15	expenses of the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges for	
16	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002	
17	\$ 18,278,770.00.	
18	SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be	
19	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State	
20	Treasury to the credit of the Commission on Proprietary School	
21	and College Registration, for the purpose of defraying the	
22	expenses incurred in the regulation and administration of the	
23	Mississippi Proprietary School and College Registration Law and	
24	the associated expenses of the State Board of Community and	
25	Junior Colleges for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and	
26	ending June 30, 2002	
27	\$ 60,000.00.	
28	SECTION 4. With the funds appropriated under the provisions	
29	of Sections 1, 2 and 3, the following positions are authorized:

31	Permanent: Full Time 41

33	Time-Limited: Full Time 1

35	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance	

- 36 with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 38 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which
- 39 are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of
- 40 this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 41 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 42 of Section 2, Six Million Dollars (\$6,000,000.00) shall be
- 43 derived from the Budget Contingency Fund created in Senate Bill
- 44 No. 2680, Regular Session of 2001.
- 45 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 46 budget requests of the administrative expenses of the State Board
- 47 for Community and Junior Colleges for Fiscal Year 2003 shall be
- 48 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
- 49 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- 50 provided during the Fiscal Year 2002 budget request process.
- 51 SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Six
- 52 Million Dollars (\$6,000,000.00) shall be expended from the Work
- 53 Force Carryover Fund as created by House Bill No. 1271, Regular
- 54 Session of 1995.
- 55 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2,
- 56 funds in the amount of Eighteen Million Thirty-one Thousand
- 57 Ninety-four Dollars (\$18,031,094.00) are appropriated for the

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58 Workforce Education Program and Industrial Training. No funding 59 obligation or commitment shall be made on behalf of the state for 60 industrial training beyond the level of funding made available in 61 this section. All industrial training program commitments made 62 in Fiscal Year 2002 and future fiscal years shall be based only upon funds available in this section and any proposed commitments 63 64 shall be approved by the Executive Director of the State Board 65 for Community and Junior Colleges, or the Executive Director's designee prior to such commitment being finalized. Industrial 66 67 training program commitments shall be made and based only upon 68 training services provided and not for a specific funding amount. Any expenditures of funds authorized in this section are limited 69 70 to obligations made July 1, 2001, or after, and shall not be 71 expended for obligations made prior to this date.

SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, funds in
the amount of One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars

(\$125,000.00) shall be derived from Community College Network

fees for the purpose of defraying the costs of the Community

College Network and the administrative expenses of the State

Board for Community and Junior Colleges.

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SECTION 10. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State 6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Board for Community 7 and Junior Colleges for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of 8 State General Funds, as authorized in Senate Bill No. 3254, Regular 9 Session of 2000, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 10 30, 2002 \$ 120,000.00. 11 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the provisions of 12 this section, in no event shall the amount expended exceed the unexpended 13 balance as of June 30, 2001. 14 SECTION 11. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the 15 State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the 16 proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the 17 State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants 18 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the 19
