REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3103: Appropriation; Student Financial Aid.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 8 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 9 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Board of Trustees 10 of State Institutions of Higher Learning for the support and maintenance of financial aid scholarship, loan and grant programs 11 12 authorized by law and administered by the Mississippi Office of 13 Student Financial Aid and for support of the Mississippi Office of Student Financial Aid, for the fiscal year beginning 14 July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... \$ 15 27,849,543.00.

SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 16 17 necessary, is hereby authorized out of the proceeds derived from 18 any federal funds, grants, donations, fees, or other special 19 source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available 20 for the support and maintenance of financial aid scholarship, 21 loan and grant programs authorized by law and administered by the Mississippi Office of Student Financial Aid and for support of 22 23 the Mississippi Office of Student Financial Aid, for the fiscal 24 year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... 25 \$ 9,875,675.00. SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 26 27 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of carryover 28 funds in State Treasury Fund 325E, pursuant to Section 37-106-33, 29 Mississippi Code of 1972, for the support and maintenance of the 30 Mississippi Resident Tuition Assistance Grant Program and the 31 Mississippi Eminent Scholars Grant Program, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... 32\$ 625,486.00. 33 34

SECTION 4. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Health Care 8 Expendable Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Board of Trustees of 9 State Institutions of Higher Learning for the support and maintenance of the 10 Medical Education Loan/Scholarship Program for the fiscal year beginning 11 July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002\$ 400,000.00. 12 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 13 Section 2, One Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,400,000.00) 14 shall be derived from the Budget Contingency Fund created in Senate Bill 15 No. 2680, Regular Session of 2001. 16

SECTION 6. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in
accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.
Provided, however, that none of the funds apportioned in this act for
the Out-of-State Educational Program shall be paid to or for the benefit of
any student who enters a school outside the State of Mississippi for the first
time, subsequent to July 1, 1982, in any discipline in the fields of medicine
or dentistry.

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that of the funds 24 appropriated under the provisions of Section 1, the Board of Trustees of the 25 State Institutions of Higher Learning shall expend from the support of the 26 out-of-state graduate and professional studies program an amount not 27 exceeding the funding necessary, contingent upon the availability of 28 qualified applicants, for ten (10) new entering optometry students and the 29 number of returning optometry students who received funding under the 30 program during the preceding school year; for ten (10) new entering 31 chiropractic students, with not more than twenty-five (25) chiropractic 32

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students overall; and seven (7) new entering osteopathic medical students
 and the number of returning osteopathic medical students who received
 funding under the program during the preceding school year, for these
 courses of study.

SECTION 8. In the allocation of funds appropriated under the
provisions of Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 among the student financial aid
programs included herein, it is the intention of the Legislature that priority
shall be given and funds shall be first allocated to all students eligible for
financial aid under the provisions of Sections 37-107-1 through 37-107-7
and Sections 37-108-1 through 37-108-5, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 9. All funds provided for in this act shall be accounted for in 43 a detailed statement showing when, to whom, and for what purpose applied, 44 and this statement shall be submitted at the next regular session of the 45 Legislature within ten (10) days after the convening thereof. A report of 46 loans made and receipt of repayment of loans to the fund shall be reported. 47 The amount of repayment that is in arrears shall also be included. Such 48 report shall include the number of students at each institution receiving 49 financial assistance and the amount of such assistance, and an estimate of 50 the financial requirement of the various loan programs for the next year. No 51 public or private institution of higher learning receiving funds under the 52 respective provisions of this act, for the purpose of issuing scholarship 53 grants or loans, shall issue any official transcripts for any persons who have 54 any amount of repayment in arrears on that date such official transcript is 55 requested. 56

Furthermore, all funds received and expended shall be reported and
otherwise accounted for in accordance with the provisions of Section
37-143-21, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the agency's
 budget request for Fiscal Year 2003 shall be submitted to the Joint
 Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to
 the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2002 budget
 request process.

SECTION 11. Any funds appropriated pursuant to this act and paid as
 a fee to or deposited in a financial institution shall be in compliance with
 Section 109 of the Constitution of the State of Mississippi and Section
 25-4-103, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 12. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the
State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the
proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the
State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants
upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the
manner provided by law.

SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after
July 1, 2001.
